## ARTICLES OF MERGER OF PARENT AND SUBSIDIARY CORPORATIONS (General Laws, Chapter 156B, Section 82)

VOTED: That the Company shall cause to be executed and filed and/or recorded the documents prescribed by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and by the laws of any other appropriate jurisdiction and will cause to be performed all necessary acts within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and within any other appropriate jurisdiction, as may be required in connection with the foregoing votes.”
