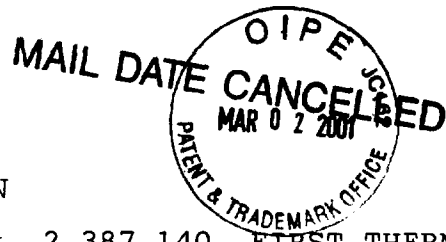



This matter having come on for determination by the Court pursuant to agreement of the parties, and it appearing that the Defendant has admitted the allegations of the Complaint, now therefore it is ordered and adjudged that the Plaintiff, Holloway & Son Construction Co., be and it is hereby awarded judgment against GenTec Equipment Company in the amount of \$241,221.59 (including rent of \$140,791.60) and its costs expended, together with interest at the judgment rate from and after the date of entry hereof. It is further ordered and adjudged that the Plaintiff, Holloway Trucking, LLC, is hereby awarded judgment against GenTec Equipment Company in the amount of \$246,909.00 and its costs expended, together with interest at the judgment rate from and after the date of entry hereof. The parties have stipulated that this judgment does not resolve the environmental issues that may exist arising out of their relationship.

This matter is retained on the Court's docket for enforcement of the Judgment and declaration of such non-judgment liens as may be appropriate.

In all other respects, this is a final and appealable Order, there being no just cause for delay of its entry.
