

NUNC PRO TUNC ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, National Electronics Warranty Corporation, a Delaware corporation located and doing business at 44873 Falcon Place, Sterling, Virginia 20166 ("N.E.W."), is the recorded owner of the mark THE GLITCH, U.S. Service Mark Application No. 75/696,155, the business associated therewith, and the goodwill symbolized thereby (the "Mark");

WHEREAS, on September 30, 1999, N.E.W. sold, assigned and transferred all of its right, title, and interest in and to the Mark to RepairNow.com, Inc., a Delaware corporation located and doing business at 44873 Falcon Place, Sterling, Virginia 20166 (hereinafter "RNC");

WHEREAS, the parties are desirous of correcting the error in the first assignment.


NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, N.E.W. has assigned and hereby sells, assigns, transfers and sets over to RNC, nunc pro tunc as of September 30, 1999, the entire right, title, interest in and to the Mark, U.S. Trademark Service Mark Application No. 75/696,155, the goodwill of the business connected with the Mark, and that portion of the business associated with the Mark, the same to be held and enjoyed by RNC, its successors, assigns and other legal representatives.

N.E.W. further assigns to RNC all right to sue for and receive all damages accruing from past infringements of the Mark assigned.

This Assignment shall be binding upon the parties, their successors and/or assigns and all others acting by, through, with or under their direction, and all those in privity therewith.
