GENERAL DEED OF ASSIGNMENT OF TRADEMARKS

Dated May 10, 2000, from Curtis Industries, Inc. , a Delaware corporation with offices at Paragon Center, 6140 Parkland Boulevard, Mayfield Heights, OH ("Seller"), to Buyer (defined below) with offices at 123 Main Street, P.O. Box 489, Bristol, CT.

Pursuant to that certain Asset Purchase Agreement dated as of the 27th day of April, 2000 (the "Purchase Agreement"), by and among BARNES GROUP INC., a Delaware corporation ("BGI"), on behalf of itself, Barnes Group Canada Inc., a Canadian corporation ("Barnes Canada"), and Bowman Distribution Europe Limited, a United Kingdom ("Bowman Europe") (BGI, Barnes Canada and Bowman Europe are collectively referred to herein as the "Buyer"), Seller and PARAGON CORPORATE HOLDINGS, INC., a Delaware corporation (the "Parent"), Buyer has purchased and Seller has agreed to sell, assign, transfer, convey and deliver to Buyer the Acquired Assets (as defined therein), including all of Seller's right, title and interest in and to the Trade Names as defined in the Purchase Agreement, and listed on the attached Exhibit A which is incorporated herein by this reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the execution of the Purchase Agreement and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged by Seller, the parties agree as follows:

1. Assignment. Seller by these presents does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey, assign, transfer, set over and deliver to Buyer, its successors and assigns, forever, its entire right, title and interest in all countries and jurisdictions throughout the world in and to:

(a) All trademarks, trade names, applications for registration and registrations thereof listed on Exhibit A attached hereto, all of Seller's business and goodwill relating thereto and all common law and other rights which Seller may have to the foregoing trademarks or trade names whether acquired by use, registration, application or otherwise; and

(b) All rights to reissues, divisions, continuations, extensions of, registrations and renewals, and all other rights, powers, privileges and interests of whatsoever nature, kind or description relating to the rights and interests referred to in paragraph (a) above including, without limitation, all benefits, claims, demands and rights of recovery that Seller has or may have in profits or damages for past and future infringements, if any, of the foregoing and all rights to compromise, sue for and collect such profits or damages as fully and entirely as the same would have been held and employed by the Seller, if this assignment and sale had not been made.

2. Further Assurances. From and after the date hereof, upon request of Buyer, Seller shall do, execute, acknowledge and deliver all such further acts, assurances, deeds, assignments, transfers, conveyances, powers of attorney, documents for recordation and other instruments and papers as may be required by Buyer to sell, assign, transfer, convey, deliver to, and vest in, Buyer record ownership in Buyer and to protect Buyer's right, title and interest in

and enjoyment of all the rights and interests hereby assigned and transferred or intended to be assigned and transferred to Buyer hereunder. The omission of any right relating to any trademark, trade name, trademark application or trademark registration from the specific terms of this Assignment shall not be deemed to limit the assignment of such right pursuant to the Purchase Agreement.

3. Power of Attorney. Seller hereby irrevocably constitutes and appoints Buyer, its successors and assigns, the true and lawful attorney of Seller, with full power of substitution, in the name of Buyer or in the name of Seller, but for the benefit and at the expense of Buyer, to take any and all action which Buyer may deem proper in order to fully vest in Buyer the rights and interests hereby assigned and transferred to Buyer in any country or jurisdiction of the world. Seller acknowledges that the foregoing powers are coupled with an interest.

4. Future Assistance. Seller further covenants that Buyer will, upon its request, be provided promptly with all pertinent facts and documents relating to the rights referred to in Section 1 above, as may be known and accessible to Seller and Seller will testify to the same in any interference, opposition or litigation related thereto and will promptly execute and deliver to Buyer or its legal representative any and all papers, instruments or affidavits required to assign, maintain, issue or enforce rights which may be necessary or desirable to carry out the purposes hereof or to record the transfer of the Acquired Assets to Buyer as provided hereunder.

5. Ownership. Seller recognizes Buyer's ownership and title to the Acquired Assets throughout the world and Seller shall not, directly or indirectly, claim adversely to Buyer any right, title or interest in and to the Acquired Assets in any country or jurisdiction of the world nor shall Seller attack the validity of this Assignment. Seller also agrees not to attempt to register to use or to aid any third party in attempting to register or to use any trademark, trade name or service mark which may be, in the opinion of Buyer, confusingly similar to any of the trademarks or trade names which are part of the Acquired Assets.

6. Successors and Assigns. This Assignment shall bind and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective permitted successors, assigns and designees pursuant to the provisions of the Purchase Agreement.
