THIS RELEASE (Trademarks) is given on this __ day of June, 2000 by General Electric Capital Corporation, as administrative agent for certain lenders ("Assignor"), to IPC Information Systems, Inc. ("Assignee"), as follows:

WHEREAS, Assignee, IPC Funding Corp, Morgan Stanley Senior Funding, Inc. ("Morgan Stanley"), Goldman Sachs Capital Partners, L.P. and General Electric Capital Corporation ("Assignor") entered into a Credit Agreement dated as of April 30, 1998 ("Credit Agreement");

WHEREAS, Assignee and Morgan Stanley entered into a Collateral Assignment of Interest in Trademarks - Short Form (the "Trademark Security Agreement"), dated as of April 30, 1998;

WHEREAS, pursuant to said Trademark Security Agreement, Assignee granted to Morgan Stanley for its benefit and the ratable benefit of the other Secured Parties (as defined in the Credit Agreement), a lien on and security interest in, inter alia, all of Grantor's right, title and interest in and to trademarks and trademark applications therefor whether then owned or thereafter acquired or created, including without limitation, the trademarks and trademark applications on Schedule A hereto (collectively, the "Trademarks");

WHEREAS, the Trademark Security Agreement was recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on June 8, 1998, at Reel 1737, Frame 0088 and Reel 1737, Frame 0109;

WHEREAS, Morgan Stanley, Assignee and Assignor entered into an Amendment to Collateral Assignment of Security Interest in Trademarks, dated December 1, 1998 ("Amended Trademark Security Agreement"), pursuant to which Assignor replaced Morgan Stanley as Administrative Agent for the Secured Parties;

WHEREAS, the Amended Trademark Security Agreement was recorded with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on December 24, 1998, at Reel 1840, Frame 0795;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Assignor hereby releases its security interest in and lien upon the Trademarks and reassigns any and all interest it may have in such Trademarks to Assignee.
