

TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, Pfizer Inc., a Delaware corporation having offices at 235 East 42nd Street, New York, New York 10017, USA, on behalf of itself and its Affiliates (collectively "Assignor") is the owner of the trademark and service mark applications and registrations, and common law rights pertaining thereto, which may include applications filed on the basis of applicant's bona fide intent to use such marks, listed on the attached Schedule A (collectively the "Trademarks") and the goodwill of the business symbolized thereby and attaching thereto; and

WHEREAS, Assignor entered into an Asset Purchase and Sale Agreement dated April 11, 2000, with Bayer Corporation ("Assignee"), an Indiana corporation having its primary offices at 100 Bayer Road, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania 15205-9741, USA, pursuant to which Assignor agreed to assign all its rights, title and interest in and to the Trademarks, to Assignee, as the successor to Assignor's entire business or that portion of the business pertaining to the Trademarks;


NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Assignor hereby sells, assigns, transfers, and conveys, effective as of June 20, 2000, to Assignee, its successors and assigns, all its right, title, and interest in and to the Trademarks, together with the goodwill of the business, or portion thereof to which the trademarks pertain, symbolized thereby, and the right to sue and to recover damages and profits and all other remedies for past infringement thereof.

ASSIGNOR hereby authorizes the Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks of the United States of America to issue the Certificate of Registration resulting from any application included among the Trademarks or renewal for any existing registration, to Assignee, its successors, and assigns, in accordance with the terms of this instrument.

This Assignment is effective as of June 20, 2000. Assignor agrees to sign any additional Assignments and other appropriate documentation necessary to effectuate and validate this Assignment under the relevant laws or regulations of the countries set forth in Schedule A, as soon as practicable after the date of this Assignment.


