WHEREAS, on or about October 13, 1998, Pacific Monolithics, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "PMI" or "Assignor") filed a Voluntary Petition with the United States Bankruptcy Court, Northern District of California ("Bankruptcy Court"), designated as Case No. 98-58279-ASW, thereby commencing a case under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code.

WHEREAS, on or about April 21, 1999, the Bankruptcy Court entered its ORDER APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING MOTION TO SELL CERTAIN OF DEBTOR'S ASSETS OTHER THAN IN THE ORDINARY COURSE OF BUSINESS (11 U.S.C. § 363(b)) AND FREE AND CLEAR OF LIENS, CLAIMS, ENCUMBRANCES, AND INTERESTS (11 U.S.C. § 363 (f)) AND AUTHORIZING ASSUMPTION AND ASSIGNMENT OF SUPPLY AGREEMENT (the "Order"). The Order authorized *inter alia*, (i) the sale of certain assets to California Amplifier, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "California Amplifier" or "Assignee"), which sale was "as is," "where is," and free and clear of all liens, claims and encumbrances; (ii) PMI's execution of an Asset Purchase Agreement, a copy of which was attached to the Order; and (iii) PMI's execution of such additional documents as necessary to consummate the sale.

WHEREAS, among the assets sold to California amplifier pursuant to the Order and related Asset Purchase Agreement, were certain trademarks, including all of PMI's right, title, and interest in and to the mark "SWITCHPOINT" (hereinafter referred to as the "mark"), which was registered in the United States Patent and Trademark Office as Registration No. 1,927,980 on October 17, 1995; and

WHEREAS, California Amplifier, a Delaware corporation having a business address at 460 Calle San Pablo, Camarillo, California 93012, and having previously purchased the entire right, title, and interest in and to the mark and the aforesaid Registration No. 1,927,980 is now desirous of confirming such purchase and further securing its ownership of the mark;

NOW, THEREFORE, Assignor hereby confirms that on or about April 29, 1999, in consideration of one dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration paid to the Assignor by the Assignee, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, THE ASSIGNOR SOLD AND ASSIGNED TO THE ASSIGNEE any and all of its right, title, and interest in and to the mark and the above-identified Registration No. 1,927,980, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by and associated with the mark.

The Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the United States Commissioner of Patents and Trademarks, and such officials in foreign countries as are duly authorized by their laws to register trademarks, to issue any and all certificates of registration of the mark to the Assignee as the owner of the entire interest, for the sole use and benefit of the said Assignee, its successors, assigns and legal representatives.

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IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Assignor has caused the hand of its duly authorized representative to be subscribed hereto.

This Assignment and Agreement shall be binding upon the Assignor's heirs, successors, assigns and legal representatives.
