

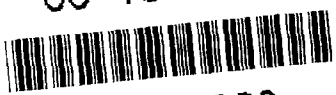


WHEREAS, Assignee desires to acquire the Marks and the above-referenced Registrations.
