

ASSIGNMENT OF TRADEMARKS

By an Asset Purchase Agreement dated October 6, 2000 the Assignor agreed to sell and Assignee agreed to purchase for the consideration set forth in the Purchase Agreement Assignor's intellectual property rights, including, without limitation, trademark rights, service mark rights and tradename rights ("Trademarks").

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Trademarks, Service Marks and Trade Names

1.1 The registered Trademarks and trademark applications of Assignor being assigned are set forth in Schedule 1 hereto.

1.2 For good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Assignor hereby sells, assigns and transfers to Assignee, its successors and assigns, all of Assignor's right, title and interest, whether statutory or at common law, in and to the Trademarks, together with the goodwill and prior user rights of the business symbolized by them throughout the world, together with all causes of action for any and all previously occurring infringements of the rights being assigned and the right to receive and retain the proceeds relating to those infringements.

1.3 Assignor agrees to execute further papers and to do such other acts as may be necessary and proper to vest full title in and to the Trademarks in the Assignee or which may be necessary, at Assignee's expense, to obtain, renew, issue or enforce the Trademarks.

2. Governing Law.

2.1 This Agreement shall be governed by, and construed in accordance with the substantive laws of New Jersey without giving effect to conflicts of laws.

The application, bearing serial number 75/748784, was filed in the Patent and Trademark Office on July 12, 1999. The enclosed specimens of use, consisting of package sealing tape labels, were in use on packages of bellows for industrial use, bellows couplings, bellows assemblies, bellows contacts, and solid shaft couplings in Class 7 (U.S. 23), at least by July 12, 1999, the date that this application was filed. The trademark was first used on the subject goods in Class 7 (U.S. 23) at least by 1957, was first used in interstate commerce at least by 1957, and is now in use in such commerce.


