ASSIGNMENT OF FEDERAL INTENT-TO-USE APPLICATION

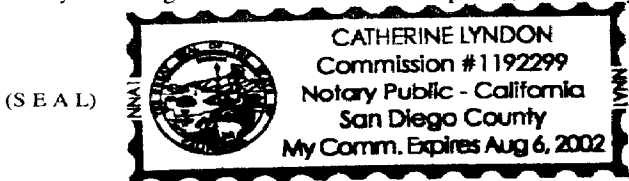
