**TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT**

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Assignor does hereby assign, sell and transfer to Assignee all right, title and interest in and to the Mark, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by the Mark, and the registration thereof, *nunc pro tunc*, effective as of March 20, 2000.

Assignor agrees to perform all reasonable and proper acts at the request and expense of Assignee which Assignee may require in order to vest all of Assignor's right, title, and interest in and to the Mark and the registration thereof in Assignee or its successor.
