INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ASSIGNMENT

ASSIGNMENT OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY, dated as of February 27, 2001, from Packard BioScience Company ("Assignor") to Canberra Industries, Inc. ("Assignee").

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by Assignor, and intending to be legally bound hereby, Assignor does hereby assign, sell, and transfer to Assignee all of its right, title and interest in and to the Assignor Intellectual Property Rights, including, without limitation, (i) all patents and applications for patents identified on Schedule A, any divisional or continuation applications that may be filed based on any such applications, any patents issued on any such applications, any reissues or certificates of reexamination of any of the foregoing patents, any foreign counterparts to any of them, (ii) all United States and foreign registrations and applications for trademarks identified on Schedules B or C hereto, and any goodwill of the business symbolized thereby, relating to the trademarks, registrations and applications (and associated goodwill), (iii) all United States and foreign registrations and applications for copyright identified on Schedule C hereto, and all rights of reversion and termination and all renewals and extensions thereof and (iv) all claims for damages by reason of past, present or future infringement or other unauthorized use of such Assignor Intellectual Property Rights.

And, at Assignee's request, Assignor will execute and deliver to Assignee any and all additional papers and generally do all other and further lawful acts as may be necessary and proper to vest full title in and to the Assignor Intellectual Property Rights,
