ARTICLES OF MERGER

Corporations Section

In accordance with Article 5.04 of the Texas Business Corporation Act, The Fred Jones Companies, Inc., an Oklahoma corporation ("Companies"), Fred Jones Enterprises, Inc., an Oklahoma corporation ("Enterprises"), Fred Jones Manufacturing Company, an Oklahoma corporation ("Manufacturing"), and Zener Electronics, Inc., a Texas corporation ("Zener"), for the purpose of merging Enterprises and Manufacturing with and into Zener, hereby set forth the following Articles of Merger:

ARTICLE I

The Agreement and Plan of Merger dated as of December 20, 1993, among Companies, Enterprises, Manufacturing and Zener (the "Plan") is set forth on Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof.

ARTICLE II

Enterprises has outstanding 295 shares of common stock, par value \$1.00 per share (the "Enterprises Shares"), all of which are entitled to vote on approval of the Plan, and none of which is entitled to vote separately as a class.

Manufacturing has outstanding 500 shares of common stock, par value \$1.00 per share (the "Manufacturing Shares"), all of which are entitled to vote on approval of the Plan, and none of which is entitled to vote separately as a class.

Zener has outstanding 200,000 shares of common stock, no par value per share (the "Zener Shares"), all of which are entitled to vote on approval of the Plan, and none of which is entitled to vote separately as a class.

ARTICLE III

All of the Enterprises Shares voted for the Plan, and no Enterprises Shares voted against the Plan.

All of the Manufacturing Shares voted for the Plan, and no Manufacturing Shares voted against the Plan.

All of the Zener Shares voted for the Plan, and no Zener Shares voted against the Plan.

With respect to each of the foreign corporations, the approval of the Plan was duly authorized by all action required by the laws of Oklahoma and its constituent documents.

Shareholder approval by Companies is not required by the Texas Business Corporation Act or the Oklahoma General Corporation Act.

ARTICLE IV

The Articles of Incorporation of Zener are amended by virtue of the merger as follows: Article One is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation is Fred Jones Enterprises, Inc."

ARTICLE V

The merger provided for herein shall be effective December 31, 1993 at the close of business.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, Companies, Enterprises, Manufacturing and Zener have caused these Articles of Merger to be executed this 28th day of December, 1993.
