## TERMINATION AND RELEASE

Fleet National Bank (the "Bank") hereby agrees that Powerspan Corp., formerly Zero Emissions Technology, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Borrower"), has satisfied all conditions and met all obligations under that certain Revolving Credit Facility by and between the Borrower and the Bank dated as of June 4, 1999 relating to a \$750,000 Revolving Note and related instruments and agreements (the "Security Agreement"), and that all indebtedness for borrowed money between the Bank and Borrower is paid in full and completely discharged. Accordingly, the Bank hereby:

1. terminates the following agreements:

a) \$750,000 Revolving Note dated as of June 4, 1999 made by Borrower and payable to the Bank;

b) Inventory, Accounts Receivable and Intangibles Security Agreement from Borrower to the Bank dated as of June 4, 1999;

c) Supplemental Security Agreement from Borrower to the Bank dated as of June 4, 1999;

d) Letter Agreement between Borrower and the Bank dated as of June 4, 1999;

e) UCC-1 Financing Statements naming the Borrower as debtor and the Bank as secured party that were filed with: (i) the Secretary of State of New Hampshire on June 7, 1999, File No. 538279, (ii) the New Durham Town Clerk on June 7, 1999, File No. 30-99, and (iii) the Strafford Registry of Deeds;

f) Security Agreement (Patents) by and between Borrower and the Bank dated as of June 4, 1999 in respect of the Patents set forth on Exhibit A hereto;

g) Security Agreement (Trademarks) by and between Borrower and the Bank dated as of June 4, 1999 in respect of the Trademarks set forth on Exhibit B hereto;


h) Security Agreement (Copyrights) by and between the Borrower and the Bank dated as of June 4, 1999 in respect of the Copyrights set forth on Exhibit C hereto;

i) Guaranty from Zero Stage Capital V Limited Partnership; and


2. releases and discharges any and all security interests, encumbrances, mortgages assignments and/or liens granted to the Bank pursuant to the foregoing agreements or instruments. The Bank hereby authorizes the Borrower to file any UCC-3 financing statements in any jurisdiction in order to effect this Termination and Release.
