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**CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT OF
ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

The undersigned, being President and Chief Executive Officer of Advanced UroScience, Inc., a Minnesota corporation, for the purpose of amending the corporation's Articles of Incorporation in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Section 302A.135, and pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Chapter 302A and Section 302A.139, states that:

FIRST--The name of the corporation is Advanced UroScience, Inc.


SECOND--Article 1 of the corporation's Articles of Incorporation is amended and replaced in its entirety as follows.
