WHEREAS, **BANK OF OKLAHOMA, N.A., AS COLLATERAL AGENT**, a national banking association having a place of business at 201 Robert S. Kerr, P.O. Box 24128, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73124 (hereinafter referred to as the "Bank"), and **EXPRESS FRANCHISE SERVICES, L.P.**, a Texas limited partnership, having a principal place of business at 6300 N.W.
