DECLARATION OF TALBOT D'ALEMBERTE

I, the undersigned, Talbot D'Alemberte, declare the following:

1. I am the President of The Florida State University.
2. The information in this Declaration is based on my personal knowledge and on the historical records of The Florida State University maintained in the ordinary course of business by employees under my supervision.
3. The Florida State University is a state university established under Florida law, and is authorized by statute to secure, maintain, and protect, in its own name, copyrights and trademarks. See Section 240.229, Florida Statutes (2001).
4. The Florida State University is located in Tallahassee, Florida. It was founded in 1851, and is a public, coeducational institution, and a senior member of the eleven state universities in Florida. The Florida State University is well known for its strong academic and athletic programs.
5. The Florida Board of Regents for and on behalf of Florida State University ("Board of Regents") was the owner of at least the ten trademark applications shown in the attached Schedule A.
6. Pursuant to legislative action effective on July 1, 2001, the Board of Regents was abolished. See Section 229.003(5)(a), Florida Statutes (2001).

7. Consequently, each university in Florida is authorized to act on its own behalf and in its own name to perform all actions necessary to secure and enforce all trademark rights. See Section 240.229, Florida Statutes (2001).

8. As a matter of state law, The Florida State University is now the proper owner of all trademarks and pending trademark applications filed with the United States Patent and Trademark Office on its own behalf, including the trademark applications shown in the attached Schedule A.

9. The undersigned being warned that willful false statements and the like so are made punishable by fine or imprisonment, or both, under 18 U.S.C. 1001, and that such willful false statements and the like may jeopardize the validity of any application or resulting registration, declares that the facts set forth in this declaration are true; all statements made of his own knowledge are true; and that all statements made on information and belief are believed to be true.
