



TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

THIS AGREEMENT entered into this 9th day of August, 2000, between **Case Corporation**, a company created under the laws of Delaware, having an office at 700 State Street, Racine, WI, USA, hereinafter collectively referred to as CASE;

**United Truck Parts LLC**, a company created under the laws of Indiana having its registered office at 122 Harvest Road, Bluffton, IN, USA, hereinafter referred to as "ASSIGNEE".

WHEREAS, CASE is the owner of the trademarks identified on Schedule A attached hereto, hereinafter referred to as the TRADEMARKS, which are used by CASE exclusively in conjunction with the business operated by the DMI Division of Case, known as the Bumper & Towing Division of, hereinafter referred as "the Business";

WHEREAS, CASE and ASSIGNEE entered a certain Asset Sale Agreement by which ASSIGNEE acquired certain assets of the Business from CASE, including the trademarks identified on Schedule A; and

WHEREAS, with ASSIGNEE having agreed to purchase the Business from CASE, CASE will transfer the TRADEMARKS and the good will associated therewith to ASSIGNEE.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of one dollar and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties, intending to be legally bound hereby, agree as follows:


1. CASE hereby assigns to ASSIGNEE all those TRADEMARKS set forth in Schedule A attached hereto **TOGETHER** with the good will of CASE associated with said TRADEMARKS as used by CASE, **TO HOLD** the same unto ASSIGNEE, and its assignees, absolutely.

2. CASE hereby consents to ASSIGNEE being entered on the Register of Trademarks of the United States as the subsequent proprietor of the TRADEMARKS.

3. To the extent necessary, CASE will provide whatever cooperation and documentation are necessary, at the request and expense of ASSIGNEE, to allow ASSIGNEE to record its interest in and to the TRADEMARKS in the country or countries corresponding to the registrations appearing on the attached Schedule A.
