DOES HEREBY CERTIFY:

FIRST: That this corporation was incorporated on the 16th day of June, 1911, pursuant to the Business Corporation Law of the State of New York, the provisions of which permit the merger of a subsidiary corporation of another state into a parent corporation organized and existing under the laws of said state.

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CARROT PUREE WITH GINGER AND ORANGE

8 SERVINGS

- 3 pounds carrots, peeled, cut into ½-inch rounds
- 4 tablespoons sugar

- ½ cup fresh orange juice
- ½ cup (1 stick) butter, cut into pieces, room temperature
- 1½ tablespoons minced peeled fresh ginger
- 1 tablespoon grated orange peel
- 1 tablespoon fresh lemon juice

Cook carrots and 3 tablespoons sugar in large pot of boiling salted water until carrots are very tender, about 25 minutes. Drain well. Return carrots to same pot; stir over medium heat until any excess moisture evaporates.

Meanwhile, bring orange juice to simmer in heavy small saucepan over medium heat. Add butter, ginger and orange peel; whisk until butter melts. Whisk in lemon juice and remaining 1 tablespoon sugar.

Puree half of carrots and half of juice mixture in processor until smooth. Transfer to large bowl. Repeat with remaining carrots and juice mixture. Season to taste with salt and pepper. *(Can be prepared 1 day ahead. Cover and refrigerate. Rewarm carrots in microwave oven on high about 4 minutes or rewarm in saucepan over medium-low heat, stirring frequently.)*

RED CABBAGE WITH APRICOTS AND BALSAMIC VINEGAR

Here's a sweet-tart addition to your menu.

6 SERVINGS

- 6 tablespoons (¾ stick) butter
- 1 8-ounce red onion, thinly sliced
- ½ teaspoon ground allspice
- ¼ teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 1 1½-pound red cabbage, quartered, cored, very thinly sliced
- ¾ cup thinly sliced dried apricots
- 1 cup apricot preserves
- ¾ cup balsamic vinegar

Melt butter in heavy large pot over medium-high heat. Add onion, allspice and nutmeg and toss 1 minute. Add cabbage

and apricots and sauté until well coated, about 2 minutes. Add apricot preserves and vinegar and toss until juices are reduced to glaze and cabbage is crisp-tender, about 6 minutes. Season with salt and pepper. *(Can be prepared 1 day ahead. Cover and keep refrigerated. Rewarm over medium heat before serving.)*

PEAS WITH CARAWAY, BLACK PEPPER AND PARMESAN BUTTER

8 TO 10 SERVINGS

- 7 tablespoons freshly grated Parmesan cheese (about 1½ ounces)
- 6 tablespoons (¾ stick) butter, room temperature
- 1 teaspoon caraway seeds
- ¾ teaspoon grated lemon peel
- ½ teaspoon freshly cracked black pepper
- ¾ cup chopped shallots
- 3 10-ounce packages frozen petite peas, unthawed
- ½ cup canned beef broth or water
- ½ cup chopped fresh Italian parsley

Mix Parmesan cheese, 4 tablespoons butter, caraway seeds, lemon peel and pepper in small bowl. *(Can be prepared 3 days ahead. Cover and refrigerate.)*

Melt remaining 2 tablespoons butter in heavy large skillet over medium-high heat. Add shallots; sauté until tender, about 3 minutes. Add peas, broth and parsley and stir until peas are heated through, about 8 minutes. Add Parmesan butter and stir until melted. Season with salt. Transfer to bowl and serve.

BRUSSELS SPROUTS WITH GARLIC, PECANS AND BASIL

Lemon peel also enlivens this terrific dish.

6 TO 8 SERVINGS

- 1½ pounds small brussels sprouts, trimmed
- ¾ cup whipping cream
- 5 large garlic cloves, chopped
- ¾ cup pecans, toasted
- ¾ cup (packed) fresh basil leaves

1½ teaspoons grated lemon peel

Fresh basil sprigs (optional)
Lemon wedges (optional)

Combine brussels sprouts, cream and garlic in heavy large skillet. Bring to boil over medium-low heat. Cover skillet tightly and cook until brussels sprouts are crisp-tender but still bright green and almost all cream is absorbed, about 10 minutes.

Meanwhile, finely grind pecans with basil leaves and lemon peel in processor.

Add pecan mixture to skillet. Toss until brussels sprouts are coated. Season with salt and pepper. Transfer to serving bowl. Garnish with basil sprigs and lemon wedges, if desired, and serve.

ONIONS WITH CURRANT, PORT AND BALSAMIC GLAZE

Just right for an elegant meal.

6 TO 8 SERVINGS

- 2 pounds small boiling onions (about ¾ to 1 inch in diameter)
- 1 cup (or more) ruby Port
- ⅓ cup dried currants
- 3 tablespoons butter
- 2 tablespoons (packed) light brown sugar
- 2 tablespoons balsamic vinegar
- 3 teaspoons minced fresh thyme

Cook onions in large pot of boiling salted water 2 minutes to loosen skins. Drain and cool slightly. Cut root ends from onions. Peel onions. *(Can be prepared 1 day ahead. Cover and refrigerate.)*

Combine onions, 1 cup Port, currants, butter, sugar, 1 tablespoon vinegar and 2 teaspoons thyme in heavy large skillet. Cover and bring to boil. Reduce heat to medium and cook, covered, 15 minutes. Uncover and cook until onions are almost tender and coated with glaze, stirring frequently, about 10 minutes. Remove from heat. Mix in remaining 1 tablespoon vinegar. Season to taste with salt and pepper. *(Can be made 1 day ahead. Cover and refrigerate. Before serving, rewarm over low heat, adding more Port by tablespoonfuls if mixture is dry.)* Sprinkle with remaining 1 teaspoon thyme and serve. ←
