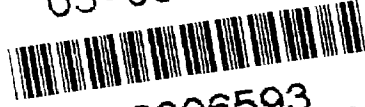

## INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ASSIGNMENT AGREEMENT

For good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and pursuant to that certain order entered on September 4, 2001 by the U.S. Bankruptcy Court ("Bankruptcy Court Order") in the Bankruptcy Case of Epic Solutions, Inc. (Bankruptcy No. 01-06199-LA11) which authorized the assignment of all interest in the Intellectual Property by Assignor to Assignee free and clear of all liens, claims and interests pursuant to 11 U.S.C. 365, EPIC Solutions, a California corporation ("Assignor"), hereby sells, conveys, assigns, delivers and otherwise transfers to Printrak International, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Assignee") all of the rights, properties and claims of Assignor as of the date hereof, of every kind, nature, character and description, tangible and intangible, wherever located, in the following property: (a) all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to all trademarks and service marks including, but not limited to those set forth on Exhibit A and all assignments, applications and other filings with the United States Patent and Trademark Office relating thereto, and all worldwide intellectual property rights therein, and (b) all of Assignor's ideas, know how, methods, designs, developmental or experimental work, improvements, discoveries, product or research plans, inventions, business and marketing plans, techniques, manufacturing and other processes, data, source and object codes, diagrams, formats, formulas, technology, supplier and customer lists, needs and specifications, technical information, reports, documents, user documentation, and all inventory (collectively, as the foregoing items in clauses (a) and (b) may exist or be in process as of the date of this Assignment, referred to as the "Intellectual Property").

All patents, copyrights (including but not limited to those set forth on Exhibit A), mask work rights, trademarks, service marks, patent or trademark or service mark applications, copyright registrations, patentable or copyrightable subject matter, and all other proprietary rights inherent in or relating to the Intellectual Property or resulting from Assignor's business (including but not limited to the right to secure those rights worldwide in the name of Assignee or otherwise, in any medium) are hereby transferred to, and shall be the sole and exclusive property of, Assignee. All patentable or trademark or service mark subject matter inherent in or relating to the Intellectual Property, and all copyrightable subject matter inherent in or relating to the Intellectual Property that is a contribution to a collective work, supplementary work, compilation, or instructional text, as these terms are defined by federal copyright laws, shall be considered assigned to Assignee pursuant to this Assignment.


