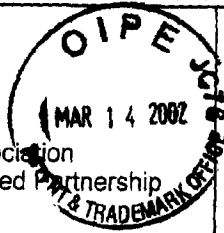


UPON HEARING READ the affidavits of Margaret B. Shannon, each sworn September 24, 1999;


