David E. McCarty and William F. Alpenfels hereby certify that:

1. They are the duly elected and acting President and Secretary, respectively, of Novel Experimental Technology, a California corporation (the "Corporation").

2. Article I of the Articles of Incorporation of this corporation is hereby amended to read in its entirety as follows:

"1.

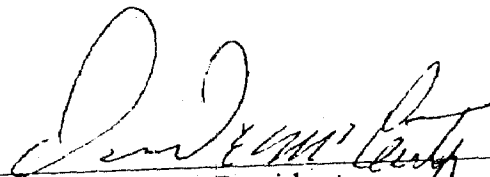
The name of the corporation is NOVEX."


3. The foregoing amendment of the Articles of Incorporation has been duly approved by the Board of Directors.

4. The foregoing amendment has been duly approved by the required vote of shareholders in accordance with Sections 902 and 903 of the California Corporations Code. The number of outstanding shares of each class entitled to vote with respect to the foregoing amendment was 6,696,790 shares of Common Stock and 42,000 shares of Series A Preferred Stock. The number of shares voting in favor of the foregoing amendment equaled or exceeded the vote required. The vote required was more than 50% of the outstanding shares of Common Stock and Series A Preferred Stock (voting on an as-converted basis) voting together.

We further declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the matters set forth in this certificate are true and correct of our own knowledge.
