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REVOCATION OF TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT

International, Inc., a California corporation; and Interpore Orthopaedics, Inc., a Delaware					
corporation (hereinafter collectively the "Parties"); all of which have a principal place of					
business at 181 Technology Drive, Irvine, California 92618.					

Relationship of Parties

WHEREAS, the Parties are related in the following manner:

- 1. Interpore International, a California corporation, merged into Interpore Delaware, Inc., a Delaware corporation, which then changed its name to Interpore International, Inc., a Delaware corporation, on May 6, 1998. Interpore International, a California corporation, subsequently dissolved on May 11, 1998.
- 2. Interpore Cross International, Inc., a California corporation, is a wholly owned subsidiary of Interpore International, Inc., a Delaware corporation.
- 3. Interpore Orthopaedics, Inc., a Delaware corporation, is also a wholly owned subsidiary of Interpore International, Inc., a Delaware corporation.

Prior Trademark Assignment

WHEREAS, a trademark assignment (hereinafter the "Trademark Assignment") was executed on June 23, 2000, whereby Interpore International, a California corporation (the listed Assignor) assigned all rights, title, and interest in the trademark applications and registrations listed in Schedule A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference (hereinafter the "Applications and Registrations"), as well as all common law rights, trade name rights, domain name rights, causes of action, and the right to recover for past infringement in connection with the marks subject of the Applications and Registration, to Interpore Cross International Limited, a California corporation (the listed Assignee);

WHEREAS, the Trademark Assignment was recorded with the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office in connection with the Applications and Registrations on July 10, 2000, entered on Reel #2113, Frame #0756.

Statements To Void Trademark Assignment

NOW, THEREFORE, for the reasons listed below, the purpose of the Revocation is to void the Trademark Assignment and return all rights, title, and interest in the Applications and Registrations, as well as all common law rights, trade name rights, domain name rights, causes of action, and the right to recover for past infringement in connection with the marks subject of the Applications and Registration, to the original Applicants or Registrants of the Applications and Registrations, as outlined in Schedule B, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

For the reasons set forth below, the Parties declare that the Trademark Assignment is void:

- 1. With the exception of the registrations for the marks PRO OSTEON, INTERPORE, INTERPORE 200 and OPERATIVE EXCELLENCE (U.S. Registration Nos. 1769078, 1512308, 1510665 and 2155337), the Assignor listed in the Trademark Assignment, namely, Interpore International, a California corporation, was not the Applicant or Registrant of the listed Applications and Registrations. Therefore, because the Assignor listed in the Trademark Assignment did not own the respective Applications and Registrations at the time the Trademark Assignment was executed on June 23, 2000, except for the previously noted marks, it was not in a position to transfer ownership of the Applications and Registrations to the Assignee, namely, Interpore Cross International Limited, a California corporation.
- 2. In addition, at the time the Trademark Assignment was executed, the Parties believed that the Assignee, namely, Interpore Cross International Limited, a California corporation, was organized and incorporated under the laws of the State of California. Upon subsequent examination, the Parties discovered that Interpore Cross International Limited was never organized or incorporated. Therefore, because the Assignee listed in the Trademark Assignment does not exist, it is not in a position to accept ownership of the Applications and Registrations as granted by the Trademark Assignment.

Amendments to Applications and Registrations

With respect to the application for the mark **PRO OSTEON**, U.S. Serial No. 76/017133, the original Applicant, namely, Interpore Cross International, Inc., a California corporation, mistakenly listed its state of incorporation as Delaware and omitted the word "Inc." from its corporate name. In recording the Revocation, Interpore Cross International, Inc., a California corporation, will instruct the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office to amend its records to accurately reflect the state of incorporation as California and add the word "Inc." to Applicant's corporate name.

With respect to the active registrations for the marks INTERPORE, INTERPORE 200 and OPERATIVE EXCELLENCE (U.S. Registration Nos. 1512308, 1510665 and 2155337), when the Parties record the Revocation, the Parties will record the merger of Interpore International, a California corporation, into Interpore Delaware, Inc., a Delaware corporation, and subsequent name change to Interpore International, Inc., a Delaware corporation.

With respect to the application for the mark INTERPORE CROSS, U.S. Serial No. 75/560633, the original Applicant, namely, Interpore Cross International, Inc., a California corporation, mistakenly omitted the word "Inc." from its corporate name. In recording the Revocation, Interpore Cross International, Inc., a California corporation, will instruct the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office to amend its records by adding the word "Inc." to Applicant's corporate name.


