**ARTICLES OF CORRECTION  
OF  
ARTICLES OF MERGER  
OF  
AIS MERGER SUB, INC.  
INTO  
AUTOMOTIVE INFORMATION SYSTEMS, INC.**

The undersigned, Jeffrey Sweet, being the President and Chief Executive Officer of Automotive Information Systems, Inc., a Minnesota corporation (the "Corporation"), and James Bazlen, being the President of AIS Merger Sub, Inc., a Delaware corporation, hereby certify the following pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 5.16:

1. The name of the persons who filed the original Articles of Merger of AIS Merger Sub, Inc. into Automotive Information Systems, Inc. (the "Original Articles") are Jeffrey Sweet and James Bazlen.
2. The instrument being corrected is the Original Articles as filed with the Minnesota Secretary of State's Office on September 7, 1999.
3. The defect to be corrected is that despite the fact that the title of the Original Articles accurately described the merger of AIS Merger Sub, Inc. into Automotive Information Systems, Inc., the Original Articles' first sentence, second sentence of paragraph (a) and first clause of the first sentence of paragraph (d) incorrectly reflect AIS Merger Sub, Inc. as the surviving corporation.
4. The corrected first sentence of the Original Articles reads in its entirety as follows:

"These Articles of Merger relate to the merger ("Merger") of AIS Merger Sub, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Acquisition") and a wholly-owned subsidiary of CSK Auto, Inc., an Arizona corporation ("Parent"), with and into Automotive Information Systems, Inc., a Minnesota corporation (the "Company").

5. The corrected second sentence of paragraph (a) of the Original Articles reads in its entirety as follows:


"The Company shall be the surviving corporation."


6. The corrected first clause of the first sentence of paragraph (d) of the Original Articles reads in its entirety as follows:


