TRADEMARK AND TRADE NAME ASSIGNMENT

This TRADEMARK AND TRADE NAME ASSIGNMENT (“**ASSIGNMENT**”) is entered into as of this 29th day of April, 2002 (the “**Effective Date**”), by and between DANIEL INDUSTRIES, INC., a Delaware corporation (“**Assignee**”), and DANIEL VALVE COMPANY, a Delaware corporation (“**Assignor**”).

WHEREAS Assignee desires to acquire all of Assignor’s rights in the DANIEL trademark and trade name, and derivatives thereof, including, without limitation, the DANIEL Design, DANFLO, and DANtrol, and the trade name Daniel Valve Company, together with all goodwill associated therewith (collectively, the “**Daniel Property**”);

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, Assignor hereby assigns to Assignee all of its right, title and interest in and to the Daniel Property, together with the right to sue for and to collect damages for past infringement of the Daniel Property.

The parties agree that this assignment by the Assignor to Assignee shall be part of a plan of liquidation and not a dividend, and is intended to be treated as a liquidating distribution occurring pursuant to a Code Section 332 liquidation of the Assignor (including a deemed Code Section 332 liquidation as a result of Code Section 338(h)(10), which is consistent with Treasury Regulation Section 1.338(h)(10)-1(e), Example 2).

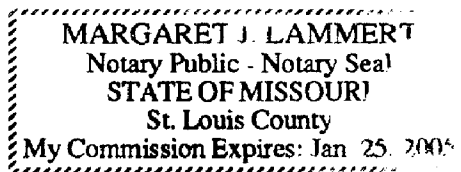
