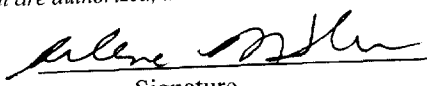

ARTICLES OF AMALGAMATION
(Section 185)

1. Name of amalgamated corporation:

Pacifica Papers Inc.

2. The place in Canada where the registered office is to be situated:

City of Vancouver, Province of British Columbia

3. The classes and any maximum number of shares that the corporation is authorized to issue:

An unlimited number of common shares.

4. Restrictions, if any, on share transfers:

No share shall be transferred without the consent of the directors of the Corporation expressed by a resolution passed by the board of directors or by an instrument or instruments in writing signed by all of such directors.

5. Number (or minimum and maximum number) of directors:

A minimum of one (1) and a maximum of twenty (20) directors, the number of directors within that range to be fixed by resolution of the directors from time to time.

6. Restrictions, if any, on business the corporation may carry on:

None

7. Other provisions, if any:



(a) The number of shareholders of the Corporation, exclusive of persons who are in its employment and exclusive of persons who, having been formerly in the employment of the Corporation, were, while, in that employment, and have continued after the termination of that employment to be shareholders of the Corporation, is limited to not more than fifty (50), two (2) or more persons who are the joint registered owners of one (1) or more shares being counted as one (1) shareholder.

(b) Any invitation to the public to subscribe for any securities of the Corporation is prohibited.

(c) The directors may appoint one (1) or more directors, who shall hold office for a term expiring not later than the close of the next annual meeting of shareholders, but the total number of directors so appointed may not exceed one-third of the number of directors elected at the previous annual meeting of shareholders.
