**AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
ROBOT AIDED MANUFACTURING CENTER, INC.**

Pursuant to sections 302A.131 et. Seq. including 302A.139 and 302A.441 of the Minnesota Business Corporations Act, Robot Aided Manufacturing Center, Inc. a Minnesota corporation, hereby amends and restates its Articles of Incorporation as follows:

Article I Name

The name of the corporation shall be "Schwan's Technology Group, Inc."

Article II Registered Office

The address of the registered office of the corporation in Minnesota is 5140 Moundview Drive, Red Wing, Minnesota 55066.

Article III Authorized Shares

The aggregate number of authorized shares of the corporation is 25,000, all of which shall have a par value of \$1.00 per share.

Article IV No Preemptive Rights

The shareholders of the corporation shall not have any preemptive rights to subscribe for or acquire shares of stock of any class, kind, or series of the corporation.

Article V Director Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by the Minnesota Business Corporation Act as the same exists or may hereafter be amended, a director of this corporation shall not be liable to this corporation or its shareholders for monetary damages for breach of fiduciary duty as a director.

Article VI Cumulative Voting

There shall be no cumulative voting by the shareholders of the corporation.

The foregoing amendment and restatement of the Articles of Incorporation has been duly adopted by the Shareholders of the corporation in accordance with Sections 302A.131 et. seq. including 302A.139 and 302A.441 of the Minnesota Business Corporation Act on February 19, 2001.

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
