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GUARANTEE AND COLLATERAL AGREEMENT

GUARANTEE AND COLLATERAL AGREEMENT, dated as of March 10, 2000, made by each of the signatories hereto (together with any other entity that may become a party hereto as provided herein, the "Grantors"), in favor of the CANADIAN IMPERIAL BANK OF COMMERCE, as administrative agent (in such capacity, the "Canadian Administrative Agent") for the Canadian banks and other financial institutions (the "Canadian Lenders") from time to time parties to the Second Amended and Restated Credit Agreement, dated as of March 10, 2000 (as amended, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "Credit Agreement"), among MAGNATRAX CORPORATION (previously known as ABCO Holdings Corp.), a Delaware corporation ("Holdings"), AMERICAN BUILDINGS COMPANY, a Delaware corporation (the "U.S. Borrower"), ONEX ABCO LIMITED PARTNERSHIP, a Nevada limited partnership (the "Tranche B Borrower"), DELTA ACQUISITION CORP. (to be succeeded by Vicwest Corporation), a corporation organized under the laws of the Province of Ontario (the "Canadian Borrower"), the several banks and other financial institutions or entities from time to time parties to the Credit Agreement (the "Lenders"), THE BANK OF NOVA SCOTIA, as syndication agent for the Lenders (in such capacity, the "Syndication Agent"), FIRST UNION NATIONAL BANK, as documentation agent for the U.S. Lenders (in such capacity, the "U.S. Documentation Agent"), THE TORONTO-DOMINION BANK, as documentation agent for the Canadian Lenders (in such capacity, the "Canadian Documentation Agent"), CANADIAN IMPERIAL BANK OF COMMERCE, as administrative agent (in such capacity, the "U.S. Administrative Agent") for the U.S. Lenders and the Canadian Administrative Agent.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Credit Agreement, the Canadian Lenders have severally agreed to make extensions of credit to the Canadian Borrower upon the terms and subject to the conditions set forth therein;

WHEREAS, the Canadian Borrower is a member of an affiliated group of companies that includes each other Grantor;

WHEREAS, the proceeds of the extensions of credit under the Credit Agreement will be used in part to enable the Canadian Borrower to make valuable transfers to one or more of the other Grantors in connection with the operation of their respective businesses;

WHEREAS, Holdings and the Canadian Borrower and the other Grantors are engaged in related businesses, and each Grantor will derive substantial direct and indirect benefit from the making of the extensions of credit under the Credit Agreement;

WHEREAS, DELTA ACQUISITION CORP. has amalgamated with JANNOCK LIMITED to form VICWEST CORPORATION;

WHEREAS, VICWEST CORPORATION has assumed all of the Canadian Borrower Obligations (as defined herein); and

WHEREAS, it is a condition precedent to the obligation of the Canadian Lenders to make their respective extensions of credit to the Canadian Borrower under the Credit Agreement that the Grantors shall have executed and delivered this Agreement to the Canadian Administrative Agent for the ratable benefit of the Canadian Lenders;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and to induce the Canadian Administrative Agent and the Canadian Lenders to enter into the Credit Agreement and to induce the Canadian Lenders to make their respective extensions of credit to the Canadian Borrower thereunder, each Grantor hereby agrees with the Canadian Administrative Agent, for the ratable benefit of the Canadian Lenders, as follows:

SECTION 1. DEFINED TERMS

1.1 Definitions. (a) Unless otherwise defined herein, terms defined in the Credit Agreement and used herein shall have the meanings given to them in the Credit Agreement, and the following terms which are defined in the *Personal Property Security Act* (Ontario) (the "PPSA") on the date hereof are used herein as so defined: Accessions, Accounts, Chattel Paper, Documents of Title, Equipment, Goods, Intangible, Instruments and Inventory.

(b) The following terms shall have the following meanings:

"Agreement": this Guarantee and Collateral Agreement, as the same may be amended, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time.

"Canadian Borrower Obligations": the collective reference to the unpaid principal of and interest on the Canadian Loans and Canadian Reimbursement Obligations and all other obligations and liabilities of the Canadian Borrower (including, without limitation, interest accruing at the then applicable rate provided in the Credit Agreement after the maturity of the Canadian Loans and Canadian Reimbursement Obligations and interest accruing at the then applicable rate provided in the Credit Agreement after the filing of any petition in bankruptcy, or the commencement of any insolvency, reorganization or like proceeding, relating to the Canadian Borrower, whether or not a claim for post-filing or post-petition interest is allowed in such proceeding) to the Canadian Administrative Agent or any Canadian Lender (or, in the case of any Hedge Agreement referred to below, any Affiliate of any Canadian Lender), whether direct or indirect, absolute or contingent, due or to become due, or now existing or hereafter incurred, which may arise under, out of, or in connection with, the Credit Agreement, this Agreement, the other Loan Documents, any Canadian Letter of Credit or any Hedge Agreement entered into by the Canadian Borrower with any Canadian Lender (or any Affiliate of any Canadian Lender) or any other document made, delivered or given in connection therewith, in each case whether on account of principal, interest, reimbursement obligations, fees, indemnities, costs, expenses or otherwise (including, without limitation, all fees and

“Guarantor Obligations”: with respect to any Guarantor, the collective reference to (i) the Canadian Borrower Obligations and (ii) all obligations and liabilities of such Guarantor which may arise under or in connection with this Agreement or any other Loan Document to which such Guarantor is a party, in each case whether on account of guarantee obligations, reimbursement obligations, fees, indemnities, costs, expenses or otherwise (including, without limitation, all fees and disbursements of counsel to the Canadian Administrative Agent or to the Canadian Lenders that are required to be paid by such Guarantor pursuant to the terms of this Agreement or any other Loan Document).

“Guarantors”: the collective reference to each Grantor other than the Canadian Borrower.

“Hedge Agreements”: as to any Person, all interest rate swaps, caps or collar agreements or similar arrangements entered into by such Person providing for protection against fluctuations in interest rates or currency exchange rates or the exchange of nominal interest obligations, either generally or under specific contingencies.

“Intellectual Property”: the collective reference to all rights, priorities and privileges relating to intellectual property, whether arising under Canada, multinational or foreign laws or otherwise, including, without limitation, the Copyrights, the Copyright Licenses, the Patents, the Patent Licenses, the Trademarks and the Trademark Licenses, and all rights to sue at law or in equity for any infringement or other impairment thereof, including the right to receive all proceeds and damages therefrom.

“Issuers”: the collective reference to each issuer of a Pledged Security.

“Obligations”: (i) in the case of the Canadian Borrower, the Canadian Borrower Obligations, and (ii) in the case of each Guarantor, its Guarantor Obligations.

“Patents”: (i) all patents of the Canada, any other country or any political subdivision thereof, all reissues and extensions thereof and all goodwill associated therewith, including, without limitation, any of the foregoing referred to in Schedule 6, (ii) all applications for patents of the Canada or any other country and all divisions, continuations and continuations-in-part thereof, including, without limitation, any of the foregoing referred to in Schedule 6, and (iii) all rights to obtain any reissues or extensions of the foregoing.

“Patent License”: all agreements, whether written or oral, providing for the grant by or to any Grantor of any right to manufacture, use or sell any invention covered in whole or in part by a Patent, including, without limitation, any of the foregoing referred to in Schedule 6.

Section 2, in bankruptcy or in any other instance. When making any demand hereunder or otherwise pursuing its rights and remedies hereunder against any Guarantor, the Canadian Administrative Agent or any Canadian Lender may, but shall be under no obligation to, make a similar demand on or otherwise pursue such rights and remedies as it may have against the Canadian Borrower, any other Guarantor or any other Person or against any collateral security or guarantee for the Canadian Borrower Obligations or any right of offset with respect thereto, and any failure by the Canadian Administrative Agent or any Canadian Lender to make any such demand, to pursue such other rights or remedies or to collect any payments from the Canadian Borrower, any other Guarantor or any other Person or to realize upon any such collateral security or guarantee or to exercise any such right of offset, or any release of the Canadian Borrower, any other Guarantor or any other Person or any such collateral security, guarantee or right of offset, shall not relieve any Guarantor of any obligation or liability hereunder, and shall not impair or affect the rights and remedies, whether express, implied or available as a matter of law, of the Canadian Administrative Agent or any Canadian Lender against any Guarantor. For the purposes hereof "demand" shall include the commencement and continuance of any legal proceedings.

2.6 Reinstatement. The guarantee contained in this Section 2 shall continue to be effective, or be reinstated, as the case may be, if at any time payment, or any part thereof, of any of the Canadian Borrower Obligations is rescinded or must otherwise be restored or returned by the Canadian Administrative Agent or any Canadian Lender upon the insolvency, bankruptcy, dissolution, liquidation or reorganization of the Canadian Borrower or any Guarantor, or upon or as a result of the appointment of a receiver, intervenor or conservator of, or trustee or similar officer for, the Canadian Borrower or any Guarantor or any substantial part of its property, or otherwise, all as though such payments had not been made.

2.7 Payments. Each Guarantor hereby guarantees that payments hereunder will be paid to the Canadian Administrative Agent without set-off or counterclaim in Canadian Dollars at the office of the Canadian Administrative Agent located at BCE Place, 161 Bay Street, 8th Floor, Toronto, Ontario MSJ 2S8.

SECTION 3. GRANT OF SECURITY INTEREST

Each Grantor hereby grants to the Canadian Administrative Agent, for the ratable benefit of the Canadian Lenders, a security interest in all of the following property now owned or at any time hereafter acquired by such Grantor or in which such Grantor now has or at any time in the future may acquire any right, title or interest (collectively, the "Collateral"), as collateral security for the prompt and complete payment and performance when due (whether at the stated maturity, by acceleration or otherwise) of such Grantor's Obligations:

- (a) all Accounts;

- (b) all Chattel Paper;
- (c) all Documents of Title;
- (d) all Equipment;
- (e) all General Intangibles;
- (f) all Instruments;
- (g) all Intellectual Property;
- (h) all Inventory;
- (i) all Pledged Securities;
- (j) all Vehicles;
- (k) all books and records pertaining to the above; and

(l) to the extent not otherwise included, all Proceeds and products of any and all of the foregoing and all collateral security and guarantees given by any Person with respect to any of the foregoing.

SECTION 4. REPRESENTATIONS AND WARRANTIES

To induce the Canadian Administrative Agent and the Canadian Lenders to enter into the Credit Agreement and to induce the Canadian Lenders to make their respective extensions of credit to the Canadian Borrower thereunder, each Grantor hereby represents and warrants to the Canadian Administrative Agent and each Canadian Lender with respect to itself that:

4.1 Representations in Credit Agreement. In the case of each Guarantor, the representations and warranties set forth in Section 4 of the Credit Agreement as they relate to such Guarantor or to the Loan Documents to which such Guarantor is a party, each of which is hereby incorporated herein by reference, are true and correct, and the Canadian Administrative Agent and each Canadian Lender shall be entitled to rely on each of them as if they were fully set forth herein, provided that each reference in each such representation and warranty to the Canadian Borrower's knowledge shall, for the purposes of this Section 4.1, be deemed to be a reference to such Guarantor's knowledge.

(d) Such Grantor is the record and beneficial owner of, and has good and marketable title to, the Pledged Securities pledged by it hereunder, free of any and all Liens or options in favor of, or claims of, any other Person, except the security interest created by this Agreement.

4.7 Receivables. (a) No amount payable to such Grantor greater than \$10,000 under or in connection with any Receivable is evidenced by any Instrument or Chattel Paper which has not been delivered to the Canadian Administrative Agent.

(b) None of the obligors on any Receivables is a Governmental Authority, other than (i) obligors on Receivables in which the notices and filings required to be made under the local Requirements of Law have been made and (ii) obligors on Receivables other than those described in clause (i) which at any time constitute in the aggregate less than 5% of the Receivables then outstanding.

(c) The amounts represented by such Grantor to the Canadian Lenders from time to time as owing to such Grantor in respect of the Receivables will at such times be accurate.

4.8 Intellectual Property. (a) Schedule 6 lists all Intellectual Property owned by such Grantor in its own name on the date hereof.

(b) On the date hereof, all material Intellectual Property is valid, subsisting, unexpired and enforceable, has not been abandoned and to the Grantor's knowledge does not infringe the intellectual property rights of any other Person.

(c) Except as set forth in Schedule 6, on the date hereof, none of the Intellectual Property is the subject of any licensing or franchise agreement pursuant to which such Grantor is the licensor or franchisor.


(d) No holding, decision or judgment in any action to which Grantor is a party has been rendered by any Governmental Authority which would limit, cancel or question the validity of, or such Grantor's rights in, any Intellectual Property in any respect that could reasonably be expected to have a Material Adverse Effect.

(e) No action or proceeding is pending, or, to the knowledge of such Grantor, threatened, on the date hereof seeking to limit, cancel or question the validity of any Intellectual Property or such Grantor's ownership interest therein, and which if adversely determined, would have a material adverse effect on the Canadian Borrower and its Subsidiaries taken as a whole.

4.9 Vehicles. Schedule 7 is a complete and correct list of all Vehicles owned by such Grantor on the date hereof.


