WHEREAS, by a Security Agreement dated September 28, 2001 (the "Security Agreement"), Owen Industries, Inc. 

(the "Subsequent Secured Party") by a Change of Name which was recorded in the records of the U.S. Trademark Office on April 22, 2002 on Reel 2499 at Frame 0981 of the U.S. Trademark Office.

NOW THEREFORE, to all who it may concern be it known that for and in consideration of the payment to the Subsequent Secured Party of the full amount of the Indebtedness, the Subsequent Secured Party hereby (a) releases and discharges all the security interests granted by the Security Agreement, being the security interests granted in respect of the patents and trademarks and all other Collateral and (b) acknowledges, confirms and agrees that the Security Agreement is discharged, released and terminated and of no further force or effect.
