**TRADEMARK SECURITY AGREEMENT
(GINGISS FORMALWEAR AND GINGISS INTERNATIONAL)**

This **TRADEMARK SECURITY AGREEMENT** (this "**Agreement**"), dated as of December 3, 2002, is entered into by GINGISS FORMALWEAR, INC., a Delaware corporation ("**Formalwear**"), and GINGISS INTERNATIONAL, INC., a Delaware corporation ("**International**"; Formalwear and International are each referred to in the remainder of this Agreement as a "**Grantor**" and collectively as the "**Grantors**"), in favor of GRYPHON ADVISORS II, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company ("**Grantee**"):

RECITALS:

A. GII Acquisition, Inc., an Illinois corporation ("**GII**"), and Gary's Operating, Inc. ("**Gary's Operating**"; GII and Gary's Operating are referred to collectively in this Agreement as the "**Borrowers**") intend to enter into a Credit Agreement, dated as of the date of this Agreement (as the same may be amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "**Credit Agreement**"), with Grantee providing for extensions of credit and other financial accommodations to be made to Borrowers by Grantee.

B. As wholly-owned subsidiaries of GII and affiliates of Gary's Operating, the Grantors acknowledge that they will receive substantial direct and indirect benefits by the making of loans and other financial accommodations to or for the benefit of the Borrowers by Grantee pursuant to the Credit Agreement.

C. It is a condition precedent to the making of loans and other financial accommodations under the Credit Agreement that the Grantors execute and deliver this Agreement.

D. Pursuant to the terms of the Security Agreement, dated as of the date of this Agreement, by and among the Grantors and Grantee (as the same may be amended, restated, supplemented or otherwise modified from time to time, the "**Security Agreement**"), the Grantors have granted to Grantee a security interest in substantially all of the assets of the Grantors including all right, title and interest of the Grantors in, to and under all Trademarks (as defined in the Security Agreement) now owned or acquired in the future by the Grantors, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by the Grantors' Trademarks, and all products and proceeds thereof, to secure the payment of all amounts owing by the Borrowers to Grantee.

In consideration of the foregoing and for other good and valuable consideration, receipt and sufficiency of which are acknowledged, the Grantors agree as follows:

1. Incorporation of Credit Agreement and Security Agreement; Defined Terms. The Credit Agreement and Security Agreement and the terms and provisions of such agreements are incorporated in this Agreement in their entirety by this reference to such agreements. All terms capitalized but not otherwise defined in this Agreement shall have the same meanings in this Agreement as in the Security Agreement.

2. Grant and Reaffirmation of Grant of Security Interests. To secure the complete and timely payment and satisfaction of the Obligations, the Grantors grant to Grantee, and reaffirms their grant pursuant to the Security Agreement of, a continuing security interest in the

Grantors' entire right, title and interest in and to the following (all of the following items or types of property being herein collectively referred to as the "**Trademark Collateral**"), whether now owned or existing or hereafter created or acquired:

- a. each Trademark and each application for Trademark, including those listed on Schedule 1, together with any reissues, continuations or extensions of each such Trademark, and all of the goodwill of the business connected with the use of, and symbolized by, each such Trademark; and
- b. all products and proceeds of the forgoing, including without limitation, any claim by the Grantors against third parties for past, present or future (a) infringement or dilution of any Trademark, or (b) injury to the goodwill associated with any Trademark.

3. Warranties and Representations. Each Grantor warrants and represents to Grantee that:

- a. such Grantor is the sole and exclusive owner of the entire and unencumbered right, title and interest in and to each Trademark, free and clear of any liens, charges and encumbrances, including, without limitation, licenses and covenants by such Grantor not to sue third persons, except for the liens created by the Trademark Security Agreement, dated as of December 12, 2001, among the Grantors and Heller Financial, Inc. in its capacity as agent for the lenders party to the Second Amended and Restated Credit Agreement, dated as of December 12, 2001;
- b. such Grantor has no notice of any suits or actions commenced or threatened with reference to any Trademark; and
- c. such Grantor has the unqualified right to execute and deliver this Agreement and perform its terms.

4. Restrictions on Future Agreements. The Grantors agree that until the Obligations shall have been satisfied in full and the Credit Agreement shall have been terminated, the Grantors shall not, without the prior written consent of Grantee, sell, pledge or assign its interest in, or grant any license under, any Trademark or enter into any other agreement with respect to any Trademark (except for any such license contained in, or entered into pursuant to, a franchise agreement entered into by a Grantor in the ordinary course of its business), and the Grantors further agree that it shall not take any action or permit any action to be taken by others subject to its control, including licensees, or fail to take any action which would affect the validity or enforcement of the rights transferred to Grantee under this Agreement.

5. Product Quality. The Grantors agree (i) to maintain the quality of any and all products in connection with which the Trademarks are used in a manner consistent with commercially reasonable business practices and (ii) to provide Grantee, upon Grantee's request from time to time, with a certificate of an officer of each Grantor certifying such Grantor's compliance with the foregoing. Subject to the terms and conditions of that certain Intercreditor Agreement, dated as of the date of this Assignment, by and among The Gingiss Group, Inc., GII Acquisition, Inc., Gary's Operating, Inc., Gingiss Formalwear, Inc., Gingiss International, Inc.,

Heller Financial, Inc., Antares Capital Corporation and the Gryphon Agent (as defined in such agreement) (the “**Intercreditor Agreement**”) and upon the occurrence of an Event of Default, the Grantors agree that Grantee, or a conservator appointed by Grantee, shall have the right to establish such additional product quality controls as Grantee, or said conservator, in its reasonable judgment, may deem necessary to assure maintenance of the quality of products sold by the Grantors under the Trademarks.

6. Grantee’s Right to Sue. Subject to the terms and conditions of the Intercreditor Agreement and the occurrence of an Event of Default, Grantee shall have the right, but shall in no way be obligated, to bring suit in its own name to enforce the Trademarks and, if Grantee shall commence any such suit, the Grantors shall, at the request of Grantee, do any and all lawful acts and execute any and all proper documents required by Grantee in aid of such enforcement and the Grantors shall promptly, upon demand, reimburse and indemnify Grantee for all costs and expenses incurred by Grantee in the exercise of its rights under this Section 6.

7. Cumulative Remedies; Power of Attorney. The Grantors acknowledge and affirm that the rights and remedies of Grantee with respect to the Trademarks, whether established by this Agreement, by the Security Agreement, or by any other agreements or by law shall be cumulative and may be exercised singularly or concurrently (subject to the terms and conditions of the Intercreditor Agreement). The Grantors authorize Grantee, subject to the terms and conditions of the Intercreditor Agreement and any license contained in, or entered into pursuant to, a franchise agreement entered into by a Grantor in the ordinary course of its business and upon the occurrence of an Event of Default, to make, constitute and appoint any officer or agent of Grantee as Grantee may select, in its sole discretion, as the Grantors’ true and lawful attorney-in-fact, with power to (i) endorse the Grantors’ name on all applications, documents, papers and instruments necessary or desirable for Grantee in the use of the Trademarks or (ii) take any other actions with respect to the Trademarks as Grantee deems to be in the best interest of Grantee, or (iii) grant or issue any exclusive or non-exclusive license under the Trademarks to anyone, or (iv) assign, pledge, convey or otherwise transfer title in or dispose of the Trademarks to anyone. The Grantors ratify all that such attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue hereof. This power of attorney shall be irrevocable until the Borrowers’ Obligations shall have been paid in full and the Credit Agreement has been terminated. The Grantors further acknowledge and agree that the use by Grantee of the Trademarks shall be worldwide, except as limited by their terms and subject to any license contained in, or entered into pursuant to, a franchise agreement entered into by a Grantor in the ordinary course of its business, and without any liability for royalties or related charges from Grantee to the Grantors.


8. Intercreditor Agreement. This Agreement, and all rights and remedies of Grantee under this Agreement, are subject to the provisions of the Intercreditor Agreement. Except as expressly permitted under the Intercreditor Agreement, (a) Grantee shall not (in its capacity as the lender under the Credit Agreement) ask, demand, sue for, exercise or otherwise assert any right or remedy in respect of all or any part of the Collateral or any Liens (as defined in the Intercreditor Agreement) thereon, or take any action to enforce, foreclose upon, take possession of or sell all or any part of the Collateral or any Liens on the Collateral, whether under the provisions of any state or federal law, including, without limitation, the UCC, or under any contract or agreement, or otherwise, and (b) the sole right of Grantee (resulting from its capacity as the lender under the Credit Agreement; it being understood that Grantee may have other rights in its capacity as a securityholder of The Gingiss Group, Inc. or otherwise) with respect to the Collateral shall be to hold a Lien thereon, to the extent granted pursuant to the Loan Documents

to secure the Obligations. Grantor shall not be required to take any action under this Agreement to the extent such action would breach or otherwise conflict with the provisions of the Intercreditor Agreement.

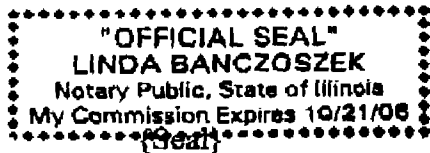
