**ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION OF  
LASALLE BUSINESS CREDIT, INC. AND DGJ, L.L.C.  
FOR EXPEDITED RELIEF FROM THE AUTOMATIC STAY  
PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. §§ 362(d) AND 105**

By Motion filed June 8, 2001, LaSalle Business Credit, Inc. and DGJ, L.L.C. moved this Court for expedited relief from the automatic stay pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 362(d) and 105 (the "Motion"). Due, proper, and sufficient notice of the Motion having been given; the Court having jurisdiction hereof; and the Court having reviewed the Motion, heard the statements of counsel, and reviewed the files and records in this case, the Court finds and concludes that good cause exists for entry of this Order pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 362(d), 105, and other applicable law.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED  
AS FOLLOWS:

1. LaSalle Business Credit, Inc. and DGJ, L.L.C. are hereby granted relief from the automatic stay pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 362(d) to take any and all actions necessary to consummate their previously noticed and repeatedly continued Public Sale of the Alleged Debtor's assets under Section 5/9-504 of the Illinois Commercial Code on Friday, June 15, 2001, at 2:00 p.m. Central Daylight Savings Time at the offices of LaSalle Business Credit, Inc., 135 South LaSalle Street, Suite 425, Chicago, Illinois 60603.

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
2. DGJ is hereby granted relief from the automatic stay, if applicable, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 362(d) to take the Leased Assets into its possession and sell the Leased Assets at private sale in conjunction with the sale described in paragraph 1 of this Order

3. The relief described in paragraphs 1 and 2 hereof is conditioned upon LaSalle and DGJ consummating a sale to PCL Packaging, Inc. ("PCL") within fifteen (15) days of the date hereof in accordance with that certain Asset Purchase Agreement between DGJ and PCL dated May 14, 2001 (the "Agreement") or to a third party not affiliated with either LaSalle or DGJ at a cash price equal to or greater than set forth in the Agreement.

4. Because of the exigent circumstances in this case, the effectiveness of this Order is not stayed pursuant to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 4001(a)(3).

IT IS SO ORDERED.
