TERMINATION OF SECURITY INTEREST IN TRADEMARKS

WHEREAS, Bradley Pharmaceuticals, Inc., 383 Route 46 West, Fairfield, New Jersey, 07004 (hereinafter the "Grantor") granted to LaSalle Business Credit, Inc., 135 South LaSalle Street, Chicago, Illinois, 60603 (hereinafter the "Grantee") a security interest in all of its rights, title and interest in and to certain trademarks and U.S. trademark registrations listed on Exhibit 1 hereto (the "Trademarks"); and

WHEREAS, Grantor granted Grantee a security interest in the Trademarks to secure its obligations under a promissory note and other obligations acknowledged in an agreement between Grantor and Grantee (herein after the "Note"); and
