WHEREAS, we **STEPHEN J. ELLEDGE**, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 2103 Addison, Houston, Texas 77030 USA; **DAVID K. CORTEZ**, a citizen of the United States of America, residing at 3043 Pecan Point, Sugarland, Texas 77478 USA; and **LEE ZOU**, a citizen of China, residing at 7575 Cambridge, Apt. 2403, Houston, Texas 77054 USA; (herein called "Assignors"), are the co-inventors and owners of a certain new and useful invention and improvement(s) entitled "**METHODS AND COMPOSITIONS IN CHECKPOINT SIGNALING**" (herein called the "Invention"), for which a provisional application for a United States Patent was filed on November 20, 2001, and a nonprovisional application for United States Patent was filed November 20, 2002, Application Nos. 60/331,821 and 10/300,453, respectively; and
