NULLITY DOCUMENT

I, JOSEPH D. HAMILBURG, declare:

1. I am Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Plymouth Rubber Company, Inc. ("Plymouth"), having an office and place of business at 104 Revere Street, Canton, Massachusetts 02021-2996. I am fully familiar with the facts herein and I submit this Nullity Document to correct title to Registration No. 1,745,734.

2. An Assignment executed on 15 January 1992 and recorded in the Trademark Office on 16 March 1992, at Reel 0851, Frame 0565 indicates that the aforementioned registration was assigned to Ring King Visibles, Inc. ("Ring King") from Plymouth. That is an error as the '734 registration has always been owned by Plymouth and both companies have so treated this registration.

3. Some time during 1992, Plymouth sold its rubber band business to Ring King. The sale also included trademark registrations which Plymouth then owned in respect of rubber bands. At that time, the '734 registration was pending as trademark application Serial No. 73/832,234. The application covered rubber bands in class 16 and electricians tape in class 17. The electricians tape portion of the business was retained by Plymouth and all registrations in connection therewith were retained by Plymouth.

4. It was subsequently decided to continue the prosecution of the application that matured into the '734 registration only in respect of electricians tape and to file a separate application for rubber bands for Ring King (formerly known as Plymouth Office Products).

5 The application filed in the name of Ring King for the mark REVERE eventually issued in the name of Ring King for rubber bands and was assigned Registration No. 1,880,564.

6. Since the original '234 application recited both rubber bands and electricians tape as the goods, it was inadvertently included in the assignment of those trademarks relating to rubber bands.

7. By error and without deceptive intent, "rubber bands" was not deleted from the '234 application and Registration '734 issued therefrom covering both rubber bands in class 16 and electricians tape in class 17.

8 The error in connection with the issuance of the '734 Registration covering rubber bands was subsequently realized and on 15 June 1994, an amendment was filed deleting rubber bands from the '734 Registration. The request for amendment was filed in the name of Plymouth as all parties recognized that Plymouth was the owner of the '734 Registration.

9. Accordingly, the assignment of application Serial No. 73/832,234, now registration No. 1,745,734 to Ring King was in error and that registration has always been treated as being owned by Plymouth.


10. It is therefore respectfully submitted that the assignment of the aforementioned '734 registration should be nullified.
