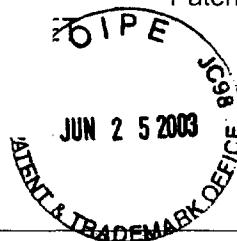

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**CERTIFICATE OF MERGER
OF
PROMATEC TECHNOLOGIES, INC.
WITH AND INTO
PERFORMANCE CONTRACTING, INC.**

CERTIFICATE OF MERGER, dated as of the 28th day of September, 2001, among Promatec Technologies, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("Promatec"), and Performance Contracting, Inc., a Kansas corporation ("PCI").

FIRST: That the Agreement and Plan of Merger, dated September 20, 2001 (the "Agreement and Plan of Merger"), among Promatec and PCI has been approved, adopted, certified, executed and acknowledged by Promatec and PCI in accordance with Section 17-6702 of the Kansas General Corporation Code.

SECOND: Promatec shall, pursuant to the provisions of the Kansas General Corporation Code, be merged with and into PCI, which shall be the surviving corporation upon the effective date of the merger, and shall continue to exist as said surviving corporation pursuant to the provisions of the Kansas General Corporation Code. The separate existence of Promatec shall cease upon said effective date in accordance with the provisions of said Kansas General Corporation Code.

THIRD: The Articles of Incorporation of PCI as in effect immediately prior to the effective date of the merger shall be and remain the Articles of Incorporation of the surviving corporation, until amended as provided by Law.

FOURTH: That the executed Agreement of Merger is on file at the principal place of business of the surviving corporation located at: 16047 W. 110th Street, Lenexa, KS 66219.

FIFTH: That a copy of the Agreement of Merger will be furnished by the surviving corporation, on request and without cost, to any stockholder of Promatec or PCI.

SIXTH: That this Certificate of Merger and the merger provided for in the Agreement of Merger shall become effective at the close of business on September 28, 2001.


SEVENTH: That a copy of the Agreement and Plan of Merger will be furnished, on request and without cost, to any stockholder of any constituent corporation.

EIGHTH: Promatec has two classes of authorized stock. The Class A shares are divided into 1000 shares of voting common stock, with no par value. The Class B shares are divided into 1000 shares of voting common stock, with no par value.



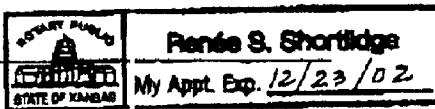
