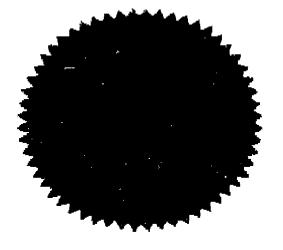

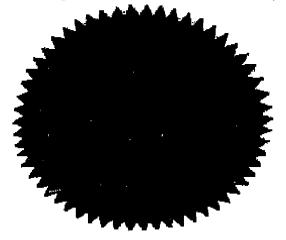

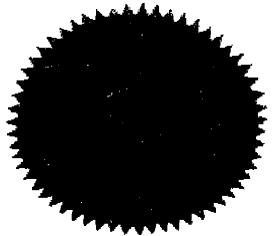

ARTICLE FIRST

The name of this corporation is Sprague Devices, Inc.

ARTICLE SECOND

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is formed is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be incorporated under the Indiana Business Corporation Law.

Upon the terms and subject to the conditions contained in this Agreement, Articles of Marger shall be duly delivered to the Secretary of State of the State of Indiana for filing, on September 1, 1992 or at such other date as the parties may agree to. The Merger (as hersinafter defined) shall become effective upon the immunes of a certificate of merger by the Socretary of State of the State of Indiana (the "Effective Time"),

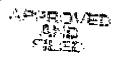
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CERTIFICATE OF MERGER OF AT LEAST 90% OWNED SUBSIDIARY

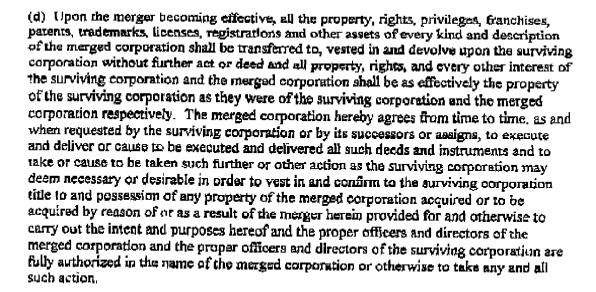

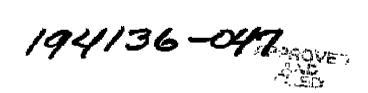
