Be it known that in consideration of the sum of ten Dollars (\$10.00), and other good and valuable consideration paid by the Assignee to the Assignor, the receipt of which is hereby expressly acknowledged, Assignor has sold, assigned and transferred, and does hereby sell assign, assign and transfer to Assignee, and its successors and assigns, the entire right, title and interest in and to said trademarks and registrations therefor, and any renewals thereof, together with the goodwill of the business symbolized by said trademarks

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and the registrations thereof, as well as all claims for damages or profits by reason of past infringement of said trademarks, the application and the registrations therefore, and the right to sue for and collect the same.
