## AUTHORIZATION AND IRREVOCABLE POWER OF ATTORNEY

I, Robert Bertoldi, whose business address is 350 Madison Ave., New York, New York, am a member of the Board of Directors of Ethentica, Inc., formerly known as Who? Vision Systems, Inc., (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Ethentica"), which formerly last did business at 26940 Laguna Hills Drive, Aliso Viejo, California 92656-2622. In such capacity as a member of the board of directors of Ethentica, I am authorized to take the actions set forth in this Authorization and Irrevocable Power of Attorney.

WHEREAS, On September 22, 2002, Ethentica sold and assigned, substantially all of its assets to Security First Corp., including all of its intellectual property rights as set forth in the Asset Purchase Agreement between Ethentica and Topspin Partners, LP<sup>1</sup>, (hereinafter collectively referred to as "IP Rights<sup>2</sup>") including but not limited to the following:

1. All patents, patent applications and patent disclosures;
2. All inventions, whether or not patentable and whether or not reduced to practice;
3. All trademarks, service marks, trade dress, trade names and corporate names, including without limitation, the name "Ethentica," and all goodwill associated therewith;
4. All registered and unregistered statutory and common law copyrights;
5. All registrations, applications, renewals or common law rights for any of the foregoing:
  - a. All trade secrets, confidential information, ideas, formulas, (whether developed or under development), know-how, manufacturing and production process and techniques, research information, specifications, designs, plans, improvements, proposals, technical and computer data, documentation and software;
  - b. all license rights with respect to intellectual property of third parties, to the extent assigned to Security First Corp.;
  - c. Confidentiality agreements, non-disclosure agreements, invention and assignment agreements, and similar agreements executed between Ethentica and any employee, consultant or agent of Ethentica or any other third party with respect to any intellectual property right of Ethentica

NOW THEREFORE, for valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I, on behalf of Ethentica, authorize and appoint Security First Corp., Mark S. O'Hare, President and CEO of Security First Corp., whose business address is 22362 Gilberto, Suite 130, Rancho Santa Margarita, Ca. 92688 and/or Howard F. Kline, VP Business Administration & Legal Affairs of Security First Corp., whose business address is 22362 Gilberto, Suite 130, Rancho Santa Margarita, Ca. 92688, as attorney in fact to act in place of Ethentica, for the purposes of drafting, executing and filing any and all documents on behalf of Ethentica, evidencing, enforcing and effectuating the sale, assignment and transfer of all of the rights, powers and interests of Ethentica to all of the IP Rights, sold, transferred and assigned to

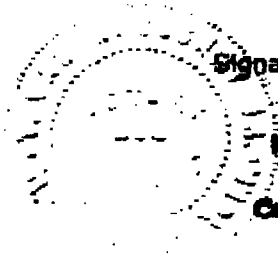
