DECLARATION OF STUART DODDS

Stuart Dodds states as follows:

1. I make this declaration on personal knowledge.
2. From 1982 to 1997, I was Editor/General Manager of Chronicle Features.
3. During that time, Chronicle Features was a division of The Chronicle Publishing Company and the business name that The Chronicle Publishing Company used in its syndication operations.
4. Chronicle Features was a party to a Syndication Agreement with Gary Larson, the creator of The Far Side cartoon. The term of the Syndication Agreement was September 1, 1979, to August 31, 1984. Chronicle Features held the copyright to cartoons Mr. Larson created under the Syndication Agreement.
5. During the term of the Syndication Agreement, Chronicle Features released the cartoons under the title "The Far Side" and with copyright notices in each cartoon, which included the date, the symbol © and the name "Chronicle Features."
6. During the term of the Syndication Agreement, The Far Side was published in The San Francisco Chronicle, a newspaper published by The Chronicle Publishing Company. During this time, The Chronicle Publishing Company registered the copyright in the newspaper, intending the registration to cover the work as a whole as well as all content within the newspaper, including The Far Side cartoon.
7. On February 2, 1995, Chronicle Features assigned and transferred to FarWorks, Inc., all rights to the copyrights in the cartoons published and syndicated under the Syndication Agreement and to the copyrights in all artwork and material created in connection with the cartoons.

8. In assigning to FarWorks "the copyrights of all artwork and other materials created in connection with" the cartoons, Chronicle Features intended to assign the copyright in both the cartoons themselves and in material based on the cartoons, including The Far Side books and calendars in which The Chronicle Publishing Company held the copyright.

9. I signed the assignment document as the duly authorized agent of Chronicle Features. As such, I was also the duly authorized agent for The Chronicle Publishing Company for matters involving its syndication operations.

10. Exhibit A to this declaration is a true and correct copy of the original Copyright Assignment that I executed and signed on February 2, 1995. The copy is sufficiently complete as it stands. The original was designated "Exhibit A" to a January 24, 1995, agreement between Chronicle Features and FarWorks, Inc.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing statements are true and correct.


