CONFIRMATORY ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, on December 18, 1995, National Fire Hose Corp., a Delaware corporation, assigned United States Trademark Registration No. 0976811 to Snap-tite Hose, Inc., a Delaware corporation, and said assignment was recorded at Reel 1508 and Frame 0321 of the records of the United States Patent and Trademark Office; and,

WHEREAS, on June 2, 1999, National Fire Hose Corp., a Delaware corporation, inadvertently executed a document which purportedly assigned United States Trademark Registration No. 0976811 to Snap-tite Technologies, Inc., a Delaware corporation, and said purported assignment document was recorded at Reel 1924 and Frame 471 of the records of the United States Patent and Trademark Office; AND, WHEREAS, said June 2, 1999 purported assignment of United States Trademark Registration No. 0976811 from National Fire Hose Corp., a Delaware corporation, to Snap-tite Technologies, Inc., a Delaware corporation, was in error insofar as Snap-tite Hose, Inc., not National Fire Hose Corp., should have been indicated as the Assignor therein; and,

WHEREAS, on June 2, 1999, Snap-tite Hose, Inc. (hereafter Assignor) a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, and now having its principal place of business at 8325 Hessinger Drive, Erie, Pa. 16509-0145, and then being the owner of the trademark N-DURA, United States Trademark Registration No. 0976811 which issued January 15, 1974, the good will of the business symbolized by said


trademark, and any all rights associated therewith, for One Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, assigned and transferred said trademark, all right, title and interest in and to said trademark and said registration, the good will of said business symbolized by said trademark and said trademark registration, and the right to sue for and collect damages for past infringement of said trademark to Snap-tite Technologies, Inc. (hereafter Assignee) a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, and now having its principal place of business at 8325 Hessinger Drive, Erie, Pa. 16509-0145; AND, WHEREAS, Snap-tite Hose, Inc. (Assignor herein) and Snap-tite Technologies, Inc. (Assignee herein) wish to confirm said June 2, 1999 Assignment;

NOW, THEREFORE, for One Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Snap-tite Hose, Inc. (Assignor) does hereby confirm said Assignment, and does hereby assign unto said Snap-tite Technologies, Inc. (Assignee) effective June 2, 1999, all right, title and interest in and to said N-DURA trademark and said United States Trademark Registration No. 0976811, together with the good will of the business symbolized by said trademark and said registration, as well as the right to sue for and collect damages for past infringement of the said trademark in its, Snap-tite Technologies, Inc.'s, own name.

This assignment document executed on the date indicated below is evidence of a previously effected assignment and transfer (nunc pro tunc) from Snap-tite Hose, Inc. to

Snap-tite Technologies, Inc., on June 2, 1999 of the N-DURA trademark and said United States Trademark Registration No. 0976811, together with the good will of the business symbolized by said trademark and said registration, as well as the right to sue for and collect damages for past infringement of said trademark.
