ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS, PPG INDUSTRIES, INC., a corporation of the State of Pennsylvania, having its principal place of business at Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania ("PPG"), is the owner of the entire right, title and interest in and to the trademarks TRIM SET, TRIM-CRAFT and TRIM-FLOCK for adhesive products ("the Marks").

WHEREAS, MASTER CHEMICAL CORPORATION, a corporation of the State of Ohio, having its principal place of business at Perrysburg, Ohio ("MCC"), is desirous of acquiring the entire right, title and interest in and to the aforesaid Marks.

WHEREAS, PPG and MCC entered into a Trademark License Agreement on February 18, 1991, the contents and provisions of which are hereby incorporated by reference.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and for other good and valuable consideration received by PPG from MCC, the sufficiency and receipt in full of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties intending to be legally bound, hereby agree as follows:

1. PPG did and now does sell, assign, transfer and convey unto MCC its entire right, title and interest in and to the Marks together with the goodwill in the business symbolized by the Marks and corresponding trademark registrations for the TRIM SET, TRIM-CRAFT and TRIM-FLOCK marks, specifically, United States Trademark Registration Nos. 1,721,028 (Serial No. 74/011,781) for TRIM SET, 1,654,013 (Serial No. 74/011,801) for TRIM-CRAFT and 1,685,899 (Serial No. 74/154,458) for TRIM-FLOCK.


2. PPG hereby covenants and agrees to cooperate with MCC whereby the latter may enjoy to the fullest extent the right, title and interests herein conveyed. Such cooperation shall include prompt execution of all papers which are deemed necessary or desirable by MCC to perfect in it the right, title and interest herein conveyed.

3. The terms of this Assignment shall inure to the benefit of MCC, its successors, assigns and/or other legal representatives.
