INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ASSIGNMENT

This INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY ASSIGNMENT (this "*Assignment*"), dated August 10, 2004, is by and between Le-Jo Enterprises, Inc., a Pennsylvania corporation ("*Assignor*"), and American Safety Razor Company, a Delaware corporation ("*Assignee*"). Capitalized terms used but not otherwise defined herein shall have the respective meanings ascribed to them in the Agreement (as defined below).

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Asset Purchase Agreement dated July 26, 2004 by and between Assignor and Assignee (the "*Agreement*"), Assignor desires to assign, transfer, convey and deliver, on a going concern basis, and Assignee desires to accept and assume, the Intellectual Property acquired thereunder on the terms and subject to the conditions set forth herein; and

WHEREAS, at the time of its contribution, the Assignor owns all right, title and interest in and to the Acquired Intellectual Property (as defined below); and

WHEREAS, as a condition to Closing, Assignor agreed to execute and deliver this Assignment pursuant to which Assignor will assign to the Assignee all of its right, title and interest in, to and under the Acquired Intellectual Property.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and mutual agreements set forth in the Agreement, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, and intending to be legally bound, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. Assignment and Transfer. Assignor hereby sells, assigns, conveys, transfers and delivers to Assignee, for Assignee's sole and exclusive use and enjoyment, all of Assignor's right, title and interest in and to: (i) the Patents and the trade secrets set forth on Exhibit A-1, together with the goodwill associated therewith, including but not limited to the renewal rights therein, the right to obtain patent or equivalent protection therein in the United States and throughout the world; (ii) the Trademarks (including all Domain Names) set forth on Exhibit A-2, together with the goodwill of the Blade Division that is symbolized by the Trademarks, including but not limited to renewal rights therein, the right to obtain registration of the Trademarks in the United States and throughout the world; (iii) the copyrights set forth on Exhibit A-3, together with the goodwill associated therewith, including but not limited renewal rights therein, the right to obtain registrations of the Copyrights in the United States and throughout the world; (iv) any and all other Intellectual Property; and (v) any and all rights to sue for claims and remedies against past, present and future infringements of any or all of the foregoing, and rights of priority and protection of interests therein under the laws of any jurisdiction (collectively, the "*Intellectual Property*").

2. Governing Law. This Assignment shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania without giving effect to conflict of laws principles.

3. Binding Effect. This Assignment shall inure to the benefit of the Assignee and its successors and assigns and shall be binding upon the Assignor and its respective successors and assigns.

4. Amendments. No modification, waiver or amendment of this Assignment shall be binding unless executed in writing by the Assignor and Assignee. No waiver of any of the provisions of this Assignment shall be deemed or shall constitute a waiver of any other provision hereof unless otherwise expressly provided.

5. Severability. If any provision of this Assignment is invalid or unenforceable for any reason, such circumstances shall not have the effect of rendering the provision in question inoperative or unenforceable in any other case or circumstance, or of rendering any other provision or provisions herein contained invalid, inoperative or unenforceable to any extent whatsoever.

6. Facsimile Signature. This Assignment may be executed and delivered by facsimile.


