**MONTREAL TRUST COMPANY OF CANADA,** formerly known as **MONTREAL TRUST COMPANY**, a trust company organized under a Special Act of legislature of the Province of Quebec referred to as an Act to amalgamate Montreal Trust Company, Crédit Foncier and Crédit Foncier Trust Company as at January 1<sup>st</sup>, 1987 (1986, Chapter 135) and continued as a trust company under the *Federal Trust and Loan Companies Act* by way of letters patent of continuance issued as at August 17<sup>th</sup>, 1994, having its head office at 1500 University Street, City of Montreal, Province of Quebec, H3A 3S8, herein acting and represented by Louis-Philippe Marineau, its corporate Trust Officer and Joanne Morette, its Administrator duly authorized pursuant to a power of attorney duly executed on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2002 by L.P.
