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ASSIGNMENT

This Assignment is between SierraPine, a California limited partnership, composed of Emmerson Investments, Inc., a California corporation, a general partner; and Rockland Timber Co., a Delaware corporation, a general partner (hereinafter "Assignor"); and Sabalito L.L.C., an Oregon limited liability company, one member of which is James Lambert (hereinafter "Assignee"). This Assignment is effective as of the date of signing by the last of the parties to sign below.

For good and valuable consideration, the parties agree as follows:

1. Assignor hereby assigns to Assignee whatever right, title and interest Assignor has in and to: (a) the trademark PLYVENEER for wood products, namely, wood veneer, wood veneer laminate; (b) U.S. Registration No. 2,597,297; and (c) whatever good will of the business Assignor has associated with the PLYVENEER trademark.
2. Assignor hereby assigns to Assignee whatever right, title and interest Assignor has in and to: (a) the trademark MIRACLE BOARD for plastic laminated corrugated paper panels primarily for use in the construction of wall partitions, room dividers, desk and tabletops and coffins; (b) U.S. Registration No. 2,409,018; and (c) whatever good will of the business Assignor has associated with the trademark MIRACLE BOARD.
3. Assignor hereby assigns to Assignee whatever right, title and interest Assignor has in and to U.S. Patent No. 5,674,593, entitled STRUCTURAL LAMINATE WITH CORRUGATED CORE AND RELATED METHOD.
4. During the term of any Assignment of Security Interest that exists or is entered into between the parties relating to the marks and patent covered by this Assignment, Assignee agrees to maintain U.S. Patent No. 5,674,593 by paying any and all maintenance fees that are required to maintain such patent, and to file Declarations of Use and Renewals concerning U.S. Registration No. 2,597,297 and 2,409,018 when due. Assignee shall continue to use the marks PLYVENEER and MIRACLE BOARD for at least some of the goods of each of the respective U.S. Trademark Registrations 2,597,297 and 2,409,018 while any such Assignment of Security Interest between the parties remains in effect. Assignee will promptly provide Assignor with proof of its payment of such maintenance fees and the filing of such Declarations of Use and Renewals.
5. ASSIGNOR HEREBY DISCLAIMS ANY AND ALL WARRANTIES OF ANY FORM AND OF ANY NATURE RELATING TO THE ASSETS ASSIGNED BY THIS ASSIGNMENT, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO WARRANTIES OF TITLE, MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR PARTICULAR PURPOSE AND/OR AGAINST INFRINGEMENT. ASSIGNOR IS TRANSFERRING WHATEVER RIGHT, TITLE AND INTEREST THAT ASSIGNOR HAS IN THE MARKS PLYVENEER AND MIRACLE BOARD, U.S. PATENT NO. 5,674,593, AND U.S. TRADEMARK REGISTRATIONS 2,597,297 AND 2,409,018 TO ASSIGNEE "AS IS." ASSIGNOR SHALL HAVE NO LIABILITY WHATSOEVER TO ASSIGNEE FOR INCIDENTAL DAMAGES, CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES, PUNITIVE DAMAGES, LOSS OF BUSINESS, LOSS OF GOODWILL, BREACH OF CONTRACT OF THIRD PARTIES,


OR LOST PROFITS, RELATING TO THE ASSETS TRANSFERRED BY THIS ASSIGNMENT, AND HEREBY DISCLAIMS ANY SUCH LIABILITY. 


