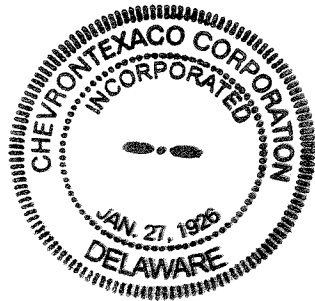
NUNC PRO TUNC ASSIGNMENT

ChevronTexaco Corporation, a Delaware corporation with its principal place of business at 6001 Bollinger Canyon Road, San Ramon, California 94583 ("Assignor"), is the record owner of U.S. Trademark Application Serial No. 78/212,366 for the mark SANGEA ("the Trademark").
