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**AFFIDAVIT OF LOST TRADEMARK ASSIGNMENT**  
**AND DECLARATION OF CHAIN OF TITLE**

I, Edward D. Baker, President of Nieco Equipment Corporation, a California corporation, having a principal place of business at 7950 Cameron Drive, Windsor, California, do hereby certify and attest to the following:


1. Nieco Corporation, a California corporation, received a trademark registration for Nieco and Design, Reg. No. 1,301,451, (hereinafter the "Trademark"), on October 23, 1984.
2. Nieco Corporation, a California corporation, was merged into Alco Standard Corporation on March 23, 1987. By function of the merger, all rights, title and interest in and to the Trademark, all the goodwill of the business connected with the use of and symbolized by the Trademark, and all causes of action related thereto was transferred to Alco Standard Corporation. A notice of this assignment by merger was recorded at the United States Patent & Trademark Office on August 31, 1987.
3. Nieco Corporation, a Delaware corporation, was incorporated on September 19, 1990.
4. All rights, title and interest in and to the Trademark, all the goodwill of the business connected with the use of and symbolized by the Trademark, and all causes of action related thereto, was assigned by Alco Standard Corporation to Nieco Corporation, a Delaware corporation, on January 28, 1992, and an assignment was recorded at the United States Patent & Trademark Office on February 3, 1992.

5. Nieco Equipment Corporation, a California corporation, was incorporated on June 10, 1992.
6. On or around June 30, 1992, Alco Standard Corporation and Nieco Corporation, a Delaware corporation, transferred all rights, title and interest in and to the Trademark, all the goodwill of the business connected with the use of and symbolized by the Trademark, and all causes of action related thereto, to Nieco Equipment Corporation, a California corporation.
7. The assignment documents evidencing the transfer of the Trademark to Nieco Equipment Corporation, a California corporation, appear to have been lost or destroyed.
8. Nieco Equipment Corporation, a California corporation, is the current owner of the Trademark; and has adopted and used the Trademark exclusively and continuously from June 30, 1992 to the date of this affidavit.
9. The undersigned has been an officer and/or principal of each of the above named companies, and has personal knowledge of all the statements set forth above.

The undersigned, being hereby warned that willful false statements and the like are punishable by fine or imprisonment, or both, under 18 U.S.C. §1001, and that such willful false statements and the like may jeopardize the validity of the application or document or any registration resulting therefrom, declares that he/she is properly authorized to execute this document on behalf of the current owner; the facts set forth in this document are true; that all statements made of his/her own knowledge are true; and all statements made on information and belief are believed to be true.
