WHEREAS, the Assignee wishes to acquire all of Assignor's rights in and to the trademarks and the goodwill associated therewith, and the trade name.

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valid consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Assignor hereby assigns, transfers and conveys to the Assignee the entire right, title and interest in the trademarks and the trade name which are used exclusively in Assignee's wiping cloth manufacturing and distribution business located in Villa Rica, Georgia, including without limitation the trademarks and trade name set forth in the attached Intellectual Property Schedule 1.1 (e), the goodwill of the business symbolized by the trademarks and trade name, the registrations thereof, and all common law rights. This sale, assignment and transfer includes the right to recover all damages resulting from prior infringement of the trademarks or trade name.

Note: There is a potential dispute with Reclaimed Textiles Co. regarding use of the trademark "Brick." In the summer of 2004 we sent a "cease and desist" letter to Reclaimed Textiles Co. demanding that they remove the term "Brick" from their packaging of certain rags. While Reclaimed Textiles Co. indicated in correspondence dated June 24, 2004 that they would do so, it has not been verified.

Note: There is a potential dispute with Ha-Ste Manufacturing regarding use of the trademark "Brick." On January 23, 2002 we sent a "cease and desist" letter to Ha-Ste Manufacturing demanding that they remove the term "Brick" from their packaging of certain mops. Ha-Ste Manufacturing, in its correspondence dated February 19, 2002, indicated their belief that the use of "Brick" with the parties' respective goods could co-exist with no likelihood of confusion.

Trade Names

- The Seller uses the trade name Steiner in connection with the Business.
