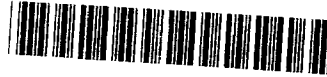

U.S. TRADEMARKS RELEASE OF SECURITY INTEREST

THIS RELEASE dated as of September 29, 2004, by Wachovia Bank, National Association (as defined below) for the Lenders. Terms used herein and not otherwise defined shall have the meanings assigned to such terms in the Credit Agreement referred to below.

A. Reference is made to the Credit Agreement dated as of February 1, 2002 (the "*Credit Agreement*"), among US ONCOLOGY, INC., a Delaware corporation with its principal offices in Houston, Texas (the "*Borrower*"), the banks and financial institutions listed on the signature pages thereto or that became parties thereto after the date thereof (collectively, the "*Lenders*"), WACHOVIA BANK, NATIONAL ASSOCIATION (formerly known as First Union National Bank), as agent for the Lenders (the "*Agent*"), UBS WARBURG LLC, as syndication agent and GENERAL ELECTRIC CAPITAL CORPORATION (d/b/a GE Capital Healthcare Financial Services), as documentation agent.

B. Reference is made to the Security Agreement, dated as of February 1, 2002 (the "*Security Agreement*"), among the Pledgors (as defined in the Security Agreement) in favor of the Agent, pursuant to which, among other things, the Pledgors granted a security interest to the Agent, for the benefit of certain secured parties named therein, in, among other things, the registered trademarks and pending trademark applications of the Borrower as set forth on Schedule I hereto (the "*Trademarks*"), which security interest was recorded with the United States Patent & Trademark Office.

C. In connection with the termination of the Credit Agreement, the Pledgors have informed the Agent of their desire to obtain the release of all right, title and interest of the Agent, the Lenders and each other grantee or beneficiary in and to the Trademarks granted under the Security Agreement.

Accordingly, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, all the Agent's right, title and interest (including, without limitation, security interests) in and to the Trademarks pursuant to the Agreement shall automatically terminate as provided in the Agreement, including, without limitation, the Trademarks set forth on Schedule I attached hereto, the debt secured thereby having been paid and satisfied in full.
