**ASSIGNMENT AND ASSUMPTION
OF TRADEMARKS**

This ASSIGNMENT AND ASSUMPTION OF TRADEMARKS is made as of June 30, 2004, by Ingersoll Rand Company (the "Assignor"), to Atlas Copco Drilling Solutions Inc., a corporation organized under the laws of Delaware (the "Assignee").

WHEREAS, the Assignor is the owner of the trademarks which are registered in, and the trademark applications which were filed with, the appropriate legal, administrative or regulatory entities in the countries and jurisdictions so indicated, as set forth on Annex A (collectively, the "Trademarks"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Asset and Stock Purchase Agreement, dated as of February 19, 2004, between Ingersoll-Rand Company Limited, a company organized under the laws of Bermuda ("IR"), Stock Sellers and Asset Sellers, including Assignor and the Assignee (the "Asset and Stock Purchase Agreement"), the Assignor has agreed to transfer to the Assignee all of the Assignor's right, title and interest in and to the Trademarks together with certain assets held by IR through its Drilling Solutions segment. Capitalized terms used herein and not otherwise defined herein shall have the respective meanings ascribed to such terms in the Asset and Stock Purchase Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties do agree as follows:

1. ASSIGNOR DOES HEREBY ASSIGN, TRANSFER AND CONVEY to the Assignee, its successors and assigns forever, all of the rights, title and interest, whether

statutory or common law, of the Assignor in, to or arising under the Trademarks, and any renewals and extensions of the Trademarks, and registrations and applications of Trademarks identified on Annex A, as fully and entirely as the same would have been held by Assignor if this Assignment had not been made, and each of the Assignor's rights to sue for, and remedies against, past, present or future infringements thereof, and rights of priority and protection of interest therein.

2. If any Trademarks owned by the Assignor is not filed, registered or recorded in the names of the Assignor, the Assignor agree to comply with Assignee's reasonable request to supply the documents required for the assignment of such Trademarks as a result of those Trademarks not being in the Assignor's name and to pay all fees associated with the filing or recording of such documents.

3. Assignor hereby authorizes and requests the trademark office in each jurisdiction in which a Trademark is registered or filed, and any official of any country whose duty it is to issue trademarks or other evidence or forms of industrial property protection on applications described herein, to issue the same to Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, in accordance with the terms of this instrument.

4. Assignor hereby further covenants and agrees that it will communicate to Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns, any facts known to it respecting the Trademarks, and testify in any legal proceeding, sign all lawful papers, and generally do everything possible to aid Assignee, its successors, legal representatives and assigns to obtain and enforce proper protection for the Trademarks in all countries Except as specifically set forth in this Agreement, Assignee shall be responsible for all costs and expenses associated with obtaining and/or enforcing the Trademarks, and toward that end,

Assignee shall pay all reasonable out-of-pocket costs incurred by Assignor in fulfilling Assignor's obligations under this paragraph 4 to aid Assignee in connection with the same.

5. Assignor pledges and agrees to provide any such further information and documentation as may be necessary to record the assignments effectuated in paragraph 1 above in the United States in any and all appropriate countries or jurisdictions. Subject to the conditions set forth in the Asset and Stock Purchase Agreement, and until the appropriate assignment document is recorded in the particular jurisdiction, Assignor agrees to take any appropriate action or authorize Assignee to take such action in the name of Assignor in connection with any Trademarks being transferred hereunder, as requested by Assignee; provided, however, that (as more generally set forth in paragraph 4 above) Assignee shall be responsible for all costs and expenses associated with any such action and toward that end shall pay all reasonable out-of-pocket costs incurred by Assignor in fulfilling its obligations under this paragraph 5 to take such action or to authorize Assignee to take such action.

6. This Assignment is made pursuant to, and subject to the terms of, the Asset and Stock Purchase Agreement. To the extent of a conflict between the provisions of this Assignment and the Asset Purchase Agreement, the provisions of the Asset Purchase Agreement shall govern.

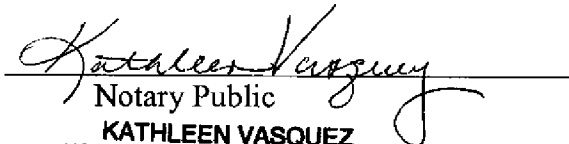
