 KEEPERS PRODUCTS, INC. AND MAINSTREAM PRODUCTS, INC.
 INTO
 PERCEPTION, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of Code of South Carolina, § 33-11-105, Perception, Inc., a South Carolina corporation ("Perception"), Keepers Products, Inc., a South Carolina corporation ("Keepers"), and Mainstream Products, Inc., a South Carolina corporation ("Mainstream") (said corporations being hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Constituent Corporations"), hereby adopt the following Articles of Merger:

- Surviving Corporation. Perception shall be the surviving corporation and shall continue to be governed by the laws of the State of South Carolina.
- Plan of Merger. The Agreement and Plan of Merger, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference (the "Plan of Merger"), was adopted and approved by the Boards of Directors and shareholders of the respective Constituent Corporations in accordance with the laws of the State of South Carolina.
- Description of Shares. The number of outstanding shares, the designations of such shares and the number of shares entitled to cast votes of each Constituent Corporation with respect to the Plan of Merger are as follows:

6. Effective Date The merger of the Constituent Corporations shall be effective on the filing of these Articles of Merger with the Secretary of State of South Carolina.




